The proposed forest land for diversion lies on Mandar Hill (Map Attached) which is notified as protected forest by Government of Bihar vide Notification No.C/P-F-10165/52-5850-R dt. 29th December 1952. The proposed forest area for diversion is .72 ha. As per enquiry report of forest officials and information provided by user agency, there is no record of any protected archeological/heritage site/defense establishment or any other important monument is located in the area. The number of trees that needs to be cut for the project is zero. This is the bare minimum forest (except for Park Area) required for the project and unavoidable.
