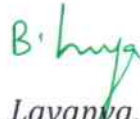

Animal passage to be provided by the user agency at location Lat- Long1) 19.11025, 79.75385 & 2) 19.11207, 79.75435 of length of 30m and height of 2.75 M as per MoEF and WII guidelines. 2. Speed breakers to be provided at every 300m length of the proposed road and speed limit on road passing through RF shall be 30KMPH. 3. Signages on wildlife movement and speed shall be placed at every 200mts.
