SITE INSPECTION REPORT AND VIOLATION REPORT

(For the Forest Land to be diverted under FCA)

A proposal has been received by this office from Ex. Engineer Road Construction Department, Jamshedpur. The user agency has applied (under FCA-1980) for **Diversion of 18.18 hectare of Forest Land for Construction of Road from NH-33 (Pipla More to Govindpur Anna More Via Ghorabandha Road Jamshedpur)**

1. The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been carried out by the undersigned (Shaba Alam Ansari, Divisional Forest Officer, Jamshedpur Forest Division Jamshedpur) on date **03/07/2018**. The list of official present during the inspection is given below:-

2. On inspection of the site, it was found that the land required by the user agency is a **Forest Area** measuring **16.75 ha.**
3. The Legal status of forest land as proposed by the user agency is as follows

RF	3.74 ha.
PF	12.30 ha.
<u>Jungle Jhari</u>	<u>0.71 ha.</u>
	16.75 ha.


It is unavoidable and is barest minimum required for the project.

4. The forest land proposed for diversion comes under dried deciduous tropical forest. The forest is mostly degraded with some degraded plantation. The propose land for diversion is in many fragrant plots. The density of the forest ranges from 0 to 0.8 and average density is 0.4. The tree present in the forest are *Acacia auriculiformis*, *Tectona grandis*, *Anacardium occidentale*, *Syzigium cumini*, *Euclyptus*, *Peltoforum spp*, *Dalbergia*, *Gmelina arborea*, *Butea monosperma*, *Terminilia arjuna*, *Bombax spp.*, *Diosyros Spp*, etc. There are 958 number of trees coming under the row of the road. At the time of operation bare minimum number of trees will be felled and the

trees having girth of 20 cm or less may be transplanted. The proposed land comes under Singhbhum Elephant Reserve. A wildlife mitigation plan is required. As the proposed land for division is mostly undulating with some hillocks in between which needs soil & moisture conservation works.

5. There is no any protected archaeological/heritage site/defence establishment or any other important monument is located in the area.
6.
 - (a) The user agency has not violated the provision of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and no work has been started without proper sanction.
 - (b) The user agency has not violated the provision of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.
7. In order to reduce the vehicular traffic inside Jamshedpur & to reduce the distance between Jamshedpur city to NH33, this proposal may be accepted.
