The area froms part of the satmala hill ranges. Geological formation is mainly Deccan trap or Basalt belongs to the type called "Plateau Basalt". The forest type is southern Tropical Dry</p>



		<p>deciduous forests with type Dry Teak Forest and southern Dry mixed Deciduous Forest. Vegetation forms main species as Teak and its associates like Dhawda Moyen, Lendi, Ain, Mahua, Tembhurni and Behada.</p> <p>The area is fairly prone to erosion, however slopes area mostly covered with vegetation and Plateau area's are covered with grasses and bushy growth of local species. Due care has been taken by the project authority to protect the sloppy of trees along by constructing Bridges, retaining walls, road side guard walls and planting of trees along roadside and plateau area. The area neither carry endangered species of Flora and Fauna nor forms part of Wildlife Sanctuary or National Park.</p> <p>The requirement of Forest land demanded by the user agency is bearest minimum and there is no any alternative Land available for the proposed project. No violation of the Forest Conservation Act 1980 is committed by the user agency and the area is inspected by the undersigned on dated 26/ 12 / 2018 compensatory afforestation scheme as prescribed by Department is enclosed with the proposal.</p> <p>As proposed by the user agency Execative Engineer, PWD, Bhokar this road is one of the important developmental project regarding the tribal development of the Nanded District. The diversion of Forest Land for non Forestry purpose is recommended and the proposal is submitted to the competent authority for consideration.</p>
