FIELD INSPECTION NOTE OF THE DISTRICT FOREST OFFICER, SANGAREDDY ON 03.12.2022 IN CONNECTION WITH THE PROPOSED DIVERSION OF FOR LAYING OF OPTICAL FIBER CABLE ALONG THE ROAD AND WITHIN THE EXISTING RIGHT OF WAY OF SANGAREDDY DISTRICT

As per the request made by the M/s. Telangana Fiber Grid Corporation Limited, Hyderabad, have inspected the site which is proposed for Optical Fiber Cable along the road and within the existing Right of way, which is passing through the Compt. No. 335 of Mambapur RF, 342,343 of Bonthapally, Jinnaram RF, 350 of Wailal RF, 354 of Puttuguda RF, 355 of Kodakanchi RF, 362, 358, 360 and 361 of Chowtakur RF of Sangareddy Range and 420 of Jukal khurd, 421 of Madwar RF, 399 of Sulthanabad RF, 411 of Nagdhar RF of Narayankhed Range of Sangareddy District, along with concerned officials of M/s. Telangana Fiber Grid Corporation Limited, Hyderabad, and Forest Department. The User Agency has requested for diversion of 0.8604 Ha of Forest land for Optical Fiber Cable along the road and within the existing Right of way.

The proposed alignment is in linear stretches passing through the Reserve Forests and the extent is 0.8604 Ha. The User Agency, M/s. Telangana Fiber Grid Corporation Limited, Hyderabad, has got the area demarcated on the ground.

During inspection it was observed that there are no trees required to be removal for laying the cable.

The total forest area involved is to an extent of 0.8604 Ha in Sangareddy District, which is also follows.


The wildlife present in the surrounding forest areas as informed by the local staff are Spotted Deer, Peacocks, Wild boars, Hares, Porcupine etc.

The area does not fail in wildlife protected areas and there is no archaeological heritage site, important monuments in the proposed alignment.

The area proposed for diversion is for laying of Optical Fiber Cable along the road and within the existing Right of Way and there is no any other alternative alignment available, except the present proposed way. This is the barest minimum area that is required for laying of Optical Fiber Cable along the road and within the existing Right of Way, to improve the communication facilities to the every Government and Private institutions and every household in Telangana State.

The User Agency has submitted undertakings to implement the following conditions:

- The User agency is hereby required to submit under taking that no labour camp shall be
 established on the Forest lands during the construction of the work "Diversion of 0.8604
 Ha of Forest Land for Execution of T-Fiber Project towards laying of Optical Fiber
 Cable along the road within the existing RoW in Forest Land in Sangareddy District,
 Telangana State in favour of Telangana Fiber Grid Corporation Ltd".,
- The Compensatory Afforestation is proposed in double the degraded Forest of 1.721 Ha

 (or) 2.00 Ha of Nizampet RF in Compt. No.405 of Narayankhed Range; which is enclosed herewith.
- 3. The Net Present Value shall be paid by the user agency as per the demand note.
- 4. The CA project Cost Shall be paid by the user agency, as per the stipulated cost.
- 5. The SMC, Boundary pillars work cost shall be paid by the user agency.
- 6. The area is free from encroachments archaeological heritage site, important monument there are no claims pending under RoFR Act.2006. There are no endangered species that are caused or harmed due to laying of Optical Fiber Cable along the road and within the existing Right of way.

The RoFR certificate in Annexure – I is awaited. It is to submit that, on behalf of the user agency the Senior Director, M/s. Telangana Fiber Grid Corporation Limited, Hyderabad, for "Diversion of 0.8604 Ha of Forest Land for Execution of T-Fiber Project towards laying of Optical Fiber Cable along the road within the existing RoW in Forest Land in Sangareddy District, has submitted and undertaking that they will submit the RoFR certificate issued by the District Collector, Sangareddy, under Recognition of Forest Rights Act, 2006; at an early date, which is enclosed herewith. However, to avoid delay in processing, I am submitting the proposal.

Further, it is submitted that we have identified the degraded forest land (having density less than 0.1) in double the extent of forest land being diverted, in Compt. No. 335, 342, 343, 350, 354, 355, 362, 358, 360, 361, 420, 421, 399, 411 of Mambapur, Bonthapally, Jinnaram, Wailal, Puttuguda, Kodakanchi, Chowtakur I & II, Jukalkhurd, Madwar-I, Sulthanabad and Nagdhar Reserve Forests of Gummadidala, Wailal, Sangareddy Sections of Sangareddy Range and Narayankhed, Sirgapoor, Kalher Sections of Narayankhed Range, as per the instructions issued vide PCCF, TS, Hyd. Rc.No.14953/2021/FCA-3, Dated. 23.10.2021.

Hence, the proposals for diversion of 0.8604 Ha of Forest land for laying of Optical Fiber Cable along the road and within the existing Right of Way which is passing through the Compt. No. 335, 342, 343, 350, 354, 355, 362, 358, 360, 361, 420, 421, 399, 411 of Mambapur, Bonthapally, Jinnaram, Wailal, Puttuguda, Kodakanchi, Chowtakur I & II, Jukalkhurd, Madwar-I, Sulthanabad and Nagdhar Reserve Forests of Sangareddy and Narayankhed, Ranges in Sangareddy District, are recommended with the following conditions.

- 1. The Legal status of the Reserve Forest land proposed to be diverted does not change.
- 2. User Agency has to put two permanent boards at the entrance and exit points of the each RF in the above locations about the status of the land and also construct boundary pillars separating the proposed area for diversion at every 20 mts interval.
- 3. The C.A land (2) Ha is proposed in Compt. No: 405 of Nizampet RF of Bachepally Beat of Narayankhed Range.

Any other conditions imposed by District Forest Officer, Sangareddy from time to time shall be followed by the User Agency.

The Proposals for diversion of 0.8604 Ha of Forest land for widening for laying of Optical Fiber Cable along the road and within the existing Right of Way are recommended.
