14.	Whether site, where the Forest Land involved is location has been inspection by the concerned Chief Conservator of Forests (Yes/No) if, yes. Date of inspection & observations made in the form of inspection note to be enclosed.	<p>No. The area proposed for the diversion 4.75 Ha.</p> <p>As per this office records, another proposal for diversion of 2.66 Ha of forest land had been submitted earlier for establishment of Halaipani SHP (12 MW) by Executive Engineer, Hayuliang Sub-Division, Department of Power. The AIP was granted vide No. 3-AP B 044/2005-SHI/1691-93 dt. 04/08/2005. But, due to non-submission of compliance for more than 5 years the AIP was revoked vide No. 03-AP B 044/2005-SHI/3267-67 dt. 14/01/2013.</p> <p>But the DPR submitted by UA under "Work Executed" shows components completed up to March/2018 with the cumulative expenditure of Rs. 12,081.38 lakhs. The DPR also mentions that the work was in full swing during 2012-13 but the cloud burst on 25-26 June/2012 led to unprecedented flood in Halai river and under construction Power House was completely damaged. Even the "Executive Summary" of DPR shows year wise cost of project but the present UA has stated it has no information about background. In Chapter 12 of DPR it is again mentioned that "the project commenced in the year 2012 in full swing but due to cloud burst event in June 2012 it got damaged".</p> <p>Since Stage II approval was not granted and the AIP was revoked in January 2013 so violation of FCA has occurred around 2012 somewhere between 2006-2012.</p> <p>The present proposal is for diversion of 4.75 Ha for establishment of Halaipani HEP (16 MW) but in the same area overlapping the earlier proposed area of 2.66 ha for Halaipani SHP (12 MW)</p>

Whether the concerned Chief Conservator of Forests agree with the information of Deputy Conservator of Forests.	<p>Yes, I agree subject to clarifications from UA as mentioned in the forwarding letter and violation of earlier Halaipani SHP (12 MW).</p> <p>The proposed area of 4.75 Ha falls partly in Pailo VRF and USF</p> <p>(i) 0.88 Ha in Pailo VRF (ii) 3.87 Ha in USF area</p> <p>The total number of trees including Poles to be felled are 188 Nos. (Poles -111, Trees -72).</p>
16.	Specific recommendation of concerned Chief Conservator of Forests for acceptance or otherwise of the proposal with detailed reasons.	<p>The proposed Halaipani Hydro Electric Project (16 MW) will assist the power scenario and so benefit the local population of Anjaw District in particular and State in general.</p> <p>Hence, recommended</p>
