The proposed diversion forest area for improvement of existing road from Karjevelly to Motlaguda (Etiguda to Agarguda via Gundepally) in Bejjur Mandal is passing through interior forest are and the surrounding areas covered with good flora and fauna and the road dead end with the village.</p> <p>During the field inspection on 30.08.2020 with Use Agency authorities and concerned staff. It is observed that (2) Culvers required for construction on the proposed road from Karjevelly to Motlaguda (Etiguda to Agarguda via Gundepally) in No. 243, 245, 256, 255, 252, 250, 249. and the User Agency authorities have also stated that they require (2) Culvert on the road proposed road and Culvert length 30 meters with a width of 8 mts and required area for Culvert is 0.06 Hac. But the user agency ha not included the culvert in this project.</p> <p>As per the field verification requirement of improvement of existing road from Karjevelly to Motlaguda (Etiguda to Agarguda via Gundepally), it is recommended the width of road for 5.00 mtr over the length is 14777.80 mts and the area diverted is 7.391 Hac and the (2) culvert length 30.00 mtr with a width of 10.00 mters and the area required for culvert is 0.06 Hac.</p> <p>As per the justification given by the user agency and the field conditions, the barest minimum and unavoidable area for the project is 7.451 Hac</p>

Thus the diversion area of 7.451 of improvement of existing road and widening from "RF Karjevelly to Motlaguda (Ettiguda to Agarguda via Gundapally) with width of 5.00 Meters over a length of 14777.80 meters (7.391 Ha), and (2) Culvert width of 10 metes over a length of 30 mts (0.06 Ha) totaling to extent of 7.451 Ha. which is falling in Bejjur Reserve Forest in Kaghaznagar Division is recommended considering all the aspects mentioned in the proposal and field conditions.
