3	Specific recommendation of concerned Conservator of Forests for acceptance or other wise of the proposal with detailed reasons?	:	<p>The proposal for Diversion of 7.451 Ha of forest land for improvement of existing road and widening from "Etiguda to Anerguda" (Karjally to Motlaguda via Gundepally) in Bejjur RF of Kagaznagar Division of KB Asifabad District in favour of District Panchayat Raj Engineer, KB Asifabad District is recommended, subject to the following conditions for safety of the wildlife and also the local villagers from accidents:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) All the debris at the site of construction of under passes shall be removed immediately after construction. b) The culverts across the streams shall be maintained and desilting shall be done once in 04 months to prevent sand / silt deposition for easy wildlife movement. c) Kindling of any fire in forest shall not be allowed. d) The work of upgradation shall be done between 9AM to 4PM only. e) Speed breakers shall be provided for every 500m length to control the speed as it is in Tiger Reserve. f) Signages on speed limit and wildlife movement/ protection shall be placed at every 500m on both sides. g) Wildlife Mitigation measures as proposed in wildlife mitigation plan shall be provided.
