

SITE INSPECTION REPORT NOT BELOW THE RANK OF DCF

A proposal has been received by this office from Executive Engineer, PMGSY-Division, P.W.D. Sonbhadra (U.P.) for diversion (under FCA-1980) of 11.790 Ha forest land for widening & Strengthening of Suarsot Khurd to Sirsiya Road form Km 0.000 to 19.200 Under Road Connectivity Project.

The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by me on dated 25/7/22

On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is a Reserve Forest measuring- 11.790 Hec.

The requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency in Col.2 of part-I is unavoidable and is barest minimum required for the project.
