FIELD INSPECTION NOTE OF THE FOREST DIVISIONAL OFFICER, KAGHAZNAGAR
IN KARJELLY RANGE OF KAGHAZNAGAR DIVISION

Today on 30.08.2020 inspected the proposed diversion area of 0.416 Hac for construction of high level Bridge at 1/00 km on road from Kethini to Dimda in Bejjur Mandal of Gudem R.F. of Kaghaznagar Forest Division in favour of District Panchyat Raj, Engineer, PIU, Komarambheem-Asifabad District along with concerned staff. As per the field verification, the details which are as follows.

The aforesaid proposed diversion area is passing through Gudem RF in Karjelly Range and the total length is 346.67 meters with a width of 12.00 meters which is amounting to the total area, required for diversion in Kaghaznagar division is 0.416 Ha.



In the proposed diversion area, no unique tree is found, no protected archaeological / heritage site / defense establishment or any other important monument is found in the area. **The proposed diversion area is falling in “Corridor of Kawal Tiger Reserve” through compartment number 182 of Karjelly Range to an extent of 0.416 ha.** There is no tree growth existing on the proposed diversion area.

The area proposed for diversion is barest minimum and unavoidable without alternatives for the project and proposed diversion forest area with a width of 12.00 meters for construction of High level Bridge is recommended. No violation against the Forest Conservation Act, 1980 has been carried out by the User Agency. Hence it is recommended for considering the proposal.
