

SITE INSPECTION REPORT

(For JHBDPL diversion of Forest land under FCA)

A proposal of Jagdishpur-Haldia-Bokaro-Dhamra Gas Pipeline, bearing No. FP/JH/Others/27162/2017 has been received by this office from **Nodal Officer, Ranchi** for diversion (Under FCA-1980) of 8.4621 ha. of forest land for non forestry purpose. The subject envisages the use of forest land **for Natural Gas Pipeline (JHBDPL)**. The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by me on dated **05.12.2018 & 01.03.2019**

On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is a forest measuring **8.4621 ha.**

The requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency in col. 2 of Part-I is unavoidable and is barest minimum required for the project.

There is no rare/endangered/unique species of flora and fauna found in the proposed area.

There is no protected archaeological/heritage site/defence establishment or any other important monument is located in the area.

The user agency has not violated the provisions of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and no work has been started without proper sanction.

The proposal is for diversion of forest land needed for construction of Natural Gas Pipeline Jagdishpur-Haldia-Bokaro-Dhamra which will facilitate the natural gas to various demand centre, industries, cities for CGD Network in India. Natural Gas will help to enhance the production of various industries like Fertilizer, Petrochemical industry power generation, manufacturing steel, textile, ceramic, glass and other industrial products situated in India.

In the larger interest of the Nation and the State, the submitted proposal for diversion of 6.4959 Ha forest land and 1.9662 ha jungle jhari land (Total 8.4621 Ha.) meant for laying of Natural Gas Pipeline from JHBDPL is being forwarded with recommendation for acceptance.
