

Inspection Report of Divisional Forest Officer, Kasaragod

Edapparamba - Kolichal Hill highway project in Kasaragod Range under Kasaragod Forest Division is passing through Adoor Reserve Forest. Total length of the proposed hill highway is 24.44 KM and stretch passes through Adoor Reserve Forest is 3.610 KM. This stretch is not continuous. It is having two stretches. First is from Evanthoor to Pandy Bajanamandir. Second stretch is from Pallathumpara - Pallanji - Parappa 2014 Mahagony plantation.


Reach I

Reach I is stable when compared to Reach II. Here 35 trees are to be removed. Forest is moist deciduous forest. Linear length in this stretch is 600 meter with 12 meter width.

Reach II

Here linear length 3 KM and width is 12 Meter. Here 347 no. of trees are to be removed. Mahagony plantation, Natural forest are the periphery regions. Here western side is slightly elevated and eastern side is slightly depressed. Expansion of the existing road may cause slight destabilization hence to be stabilized by proper corrective measures.
