
Inspection notes of Sri G.Lakshman, S.F.S., Divisional Forest Officer, Vizianagaram on the road proposals received from the user agency i.e., Executive Engineer, Panchayat Raj, (P.I.U.) Vizianagram for the road proposed from Karakavalasa to Marika of Vepada mandal on 15.10.2018

Inspected the proposed road from Karakavaasa to Marika of Vepada mandal on 15.10.2018 accompanied by the Assistant Executive Engineer, P.R., (P.I.U) S.Kota along with Dy. Range Officer, S.Kota and staff. The said proposed road is kutcha road and utilizing by the villagers in and around for their day to day movement. The total length of the road proposed is 8.884 kms from Karakavalas to Mariaka, out of which 5800 meters length is falling inside the Marika R.F., The proposed width of the road is 7.50 meters and at curves 9.00 meters is required. The total Forest area to be diverted is 4.38 hectors covering in Compartment Nos.268, 276 and 277 of Marika R.F., The proposed road was also surveyed by the D.G.P.S., and starts with the G.P.S. readings N 18.03797758, E 83.09764184 and ends at N 18.04653099, E 83.03571420. The D.G.P.S. data was authenticated by the G.I.S. wing, O/o Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests, A.P., Guntur. There are no trees falling along the width of the proposed road. The density of the Forests on the proposed width of the road is 0.1 to 0.4 The villagers of Marika are very much need of this road for their day to day movement to hospitals, Schools for their children and marketing their Agricultural products. This is an essential for the movement of all the Departments to extend the Government activities to all the Tribals to bring them in the main stream. There is no violation of work taken place and the required Forest area is unavoidable and no endangered and unique species of Flora and Fauna and no protected Archeological Heritage importance in this locality.





The District Collector, Vizianagaram has furnished the certificate (Annexure-I) Form-I regarding the completion of process for identification and settlement of Rights under F.R.A. for this road proposal and also stated that this proposal does not involve Recognized Right of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre Agricultural Communities.
