On date 05.07.2009 the land bearing Gat number 464 was handed over from Revenue department to forest dept and company was not aware of these changes among the departments, further till the completion of road none of the objections was raised by authorities.
- After this handing over process between the two departments took place the offence was booked by forest department. (Offence No. ATTI.3/201213 dated 09.08.2012)
