

Site Inspection Report


Name of Project :- **Strengthening and Widening of Chaibasa-Tonto-Roam Road.**
Date of Inspection :- 17.02.2022
Proposed Area of Forest Diversion :- **21.931 ha.**
Kolhan Division - 11.093 ha
and Chaibasa Division - 10.838 ha

On inspection of the site, it was found that the requirement of the forest land as proposed by the user agency is unavoidable and is bare minimum for the project. The average canopy density of the area is 0.65 with Eco-class III.

The linear project is located in Singhbhum Elephant Reserve. So, a Wildlife Mitigation Plan is needed to prevent the adverse effects of the proposed project on both flora and fauna of the Divisions and it is extremely important for the conservation of Wildlife habitat.

Besides, the area proposed the diversion in both the Divisions have hilly terrain and Forest Land is prone to soil erosion, So a Soil Conservation Plan is needed for mitigation of land degradation and re-vegetation of eroded land and attaining sustainable land use.

The proposal is strategically important and is recommended in the wider interest of the public.
