

Site inspection report of diversion of 1.99 Ha. Forest land for Setting up of Police / CRPF Camp for Anti-Extremist Operation duties in Inter State Border.

I have inspected the proposed CRPF Camp area in Charla Range along with Forest Range Officer, Charla and concerned staff on 24.02.2021. The proposed Police/CRPF Camp is situated in the midst of the Pedamidisileru Reserve forest area near Chennapuram village. The approach road Chennapuram, which is passing through Compt.No.71B of Thippapuram(S) beat of Thippapuram section of Charla Range, which is formed illegally long back. The details of the diverted area is as shown below.

The User Agency is proposed an extent of area is 1.99 Ha. for the diversion of the forest land for deployment of Police/CRPF camp near Chennapuram village of Thippapuram(s) beat of Thippapuram section in Charla Range, Bhadrachalam Division of Bhadrachalam District, Kothagudem for anti extremist Operations duties in the interstate bordering areas. Therefore the diversion of the forest land for the above proposed project is recommended for 1.99 Ha.

The proposed area is contains miscellaneous tree growth with medium girth class trees and few valuable timber trees are present. Project does not cause any harm to the local flora and fauna. The proposed project is a public important project under left wing extremism affected areas.

The site proposed for diversion is falling in the forest type of Southern Tropical Dry Deciduous Forests (5A) as per Champion and Seth classification. The vegetation is of miscellaneous type with predominant species of *Tectona Grandis*, *Morinda Clrifolia*, *Madhuka Indica*, *Diospyros melanoxylon*, *Pterocarpus marsupium* etc., The type of soil is Red. The average crop density is 0.40. The proposed site for diversion is plain and not vulnerable to erosion.
