SITE INSPECTION REPORT NOT BELOW THE RANK OF DCF

(For the Forest Land to be diverted under FCA)

A proposal has been received by this office from Executive Engineer PHED Project Division Chittorgarh for diversion (under FCA-1980) of 2.303 Ha. of forest land for non forestry purpose. The subject envisages the use of forest land for Bhainsrorgarh Borav Water supply Project District, Chittorgarh. The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by me on dated 11-06-2018 with forest staff and PHED staff Chittorgarh.

On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is a forest measuring 2.303 Ha. Which fall under different forest block of Jawahar Sagar Sanctuary ie. Peermagra (Reserve Forest 0.7320 ha.), Balapura (Protected Forest 0.1870 Ha.), Bhaisrorgarh (Protected Forest 0.0320 Ha.), Khal Gaon (Protected Forest 0.134 Ha.), Shreepura (Protected Forest 0.7840Ha.) and Bhunjar (Reserve Forest 0.4340 Ha.) Total 2.303 Ha. Forest land and 7.96208 Ha. non forest land falls under Jawahar Sagar Sanctuary area.

The requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency in Col. 2 of part-I is unavoidable and is barest minimum required for the project.

There is no any rare/endangered/unique species of flora and fauna found in the area.

There is no any protected archaeological/heritage site/defence establishment or any other important monument is located in the area.

It has been found that the user agency has NOT violated the forest (Conversion) Act, 1980 provision till date and no work has been started without prior permission.

Since the project Bhaisrodgarh Borav Water Supply District Chittorgarh is important for providing drinking water in the revenue habitation in the area, hence in view of the importance and need of supply of drinking water in the revenue villages and revenue habitations project is recommended for acceptance.
