Retail outlet (Haidargarh- Bhitariya Road)** In km. 8.00-9.00, Gata No 110, Village: Dulahdepur, Tahshil: Ramsanehighat, Dist: Barabanki The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by me on dated 02-01-2018
