

## SITE INSPECTION REPORT (NOT BELOW THE RANK OF DCF)

### (for the forest land to be diverted under FCA)

A proposal has been received by this office from the Sr. Section Engineer, Work/Construction/Sultanpur N. Railway Lucknow U.P. for diversion of 34.3636 ha. of forest land for non-forestry purpose. The project envisages the use of forest land for the purpose of Railway Track Doubling between Km no. 823.250 to 874-355 in Zafrabad – Akbarpur. The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by me on 22.06.2020. On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is the protected forest measuring 34.3636 ha.

The requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency in column-2 of Part-1 is unavoidable and bare minimum required for the project.
