## FIELD INSPECTION NOTES OF THE DISTRICT FOREST OFFICER, MEDAK IN RESERVE FOREST LAND ON 04.04.2020

Today I along with the Forest Range Officer, Toopran and their field staff have inspected the Reserve Forest areas proposed for Diversion of Forest Land to an extent of 1.2222 Ha in Medak District for execution of 132 KV DC/SC line from 400KV SS at Narsapur to proposed 132 KV RTSS at Manoharabad in favour of Executive Engineer, Construction, TS TRANSCO, Sangareddy as detailed below:

The said area is passing through these RF's to a length of about 452.66 mts and width 27 meters as mentioned above. The canopy of these areas is 0.2 to 0.3 and there are no trees are required to be removed from the said area. The proposed area is not prone for soil erosion.

I have searched for other alternatives, but there is no alternative land available except the present proposal. This is the barest minimum area that is required for execution of 132 KV DC/SC line from 400KV SS at Narsapur to proposed 132 KV RTSS at Manoharabad of Toopran Mandal of Gajwel Assembly Constituency in Medak District. The CA DFL is proposed for an area of 2.4444 Ha in Compt.No.183 and Parkibanda-I of Parkibanda Beat of Manoharabad Section of Toopran Range (Map enclosed).

There is no rare/endangered unique species of flora and fauna in the area proposed for diversion. In the proposed site, there are no protected/Archaeological/Heritage site /Defence establishment or any other important monuments are located. No work is started as on date in violation of FC Act 1980. There are no encroachments and claims in the RF area that attracts the RoFR Act 2006. The RoFR certificates in Form-I from District Collector has been furnished along with the DLC, SDLC and Gram Sabha.,
