Site Inspection Report of Conservator of Forest, Territorial Circle, Gumla

Proposal has been received by this office for diversion (under FCA-1980) of 8.7139 ha of forest land for non forestry purpose from Divisional Forest Officer, Gumla and Divisional Forest Officer, Simdega. The subject envisages the use of forest land for Jagdishpur-Haldia-Bokaro-Dhamra Gas Pipeline Construction. The Site Inspection of the Land in the jurisdiction of Simdega Forest Division has been done by me on 08.01.2019.

On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is forest measuring 8.4621 ha in the jurisdiction of Simdega Forest Division.

The requirement of forest land as detailed by the DFO in Columns 2 of part –II is unavoidable and is barest minimum required for the Project.

The site under proposal do not have any protected heritage site/defense establishment /or any other important monument located in the area.

Wild bear is resident in the area. The wild elephant -Loner and herd -use to move in the area very frequently. Wild boar, Hyena, etc have been reported to be found in the area. Site specific wildlife management plan my be required to ensure conservation and management of wildlife.

The project is ambitious and priority. The construction involves bare minimum forest land. So recommended.
