Sub: - Proposal for diversion of 27.343 ha. of forest land for widening of existing 2 lane to 2 lane with 1.5 Mtr. Wide paved shoulder from Km 0/0 to 81/00 & 93/00 to 119/00 of N.H.-157 on vide proposal No.FP/OR/ROAD/31054/2014.

It is to inform you that the Divisional Forest Officers, Gh.North and Phulbani Division have submitted proposal vide their Memo No.1917 dated 15.04.2019 and Memo No.1346 dated 15.04.2019 respectively for diversion of forest land over Gh.North 19.621 ha. + Phulbani 7.722 ha. = 27.343 ha. for widening of existing 2 lane to 2 lane with 1.5 Mtr. Wide paved shoulder from Km 0/0 to 81/00 & 93/00 to 119/00 of N.H.-157 vide proposal No.FP/OR/ROAD/31054/2014 after compilation of Part-II of the proposal and uploading in the website of MoEF & CC, Government of India.



North Division) on EPC mode in State of Odisha, aims to improve socio-economic development and to provide safety of vehicular traffic and increase of fuel efficiency of vehicles plying on this road.</p> <p>It will allow speedy movement of vehicles in the left wing affected area and help in socio-economic growth of the area.</p> <p>Since the project is initiated with a larger interest of general public of locality vis-à-vis the State as a whole, the proposal for diversion of 27.343 ha of forest land for widening of existing 2 lane to 2 lane with 1.5 m wide paved shoulder on both sides of road (NH-157) from Km 0/0 to 81/00 and 93/00 to 119/00 is recommended.</p>
