Proposal has been received by this office from SJVN, LHEP Bithal for diversion (under FCA-1980) of 0.9486 hac of additional forest land for Luhri HEP Stage -1 (210MW) Bithal Shimla for the construction of approach road for Moin Quarry site respect of Ani Forest Division.

The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been conducted by me on dated 22.10.2019

1. On inspection of the site, it is found that the proposed land measuring **0.9486 hac.** is running through existing path and is part of UPF Nither & UPF Moin.
2. The requirement of forestland as proposed by the user agency in Col. 2 of part-I is unavoidable and is barest minimum required for the project.
3. No rare/ endangered/ unique species of flora and fauna found in the area.
4. No protected archaeological/ heritage site/ defense establishment or any other important monument is located in the area.
5. (a) **The user agency has not violated the provisions of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and no work has been started without proper sanction.**  
(b) It has been found that the user agency has violated the provisions of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 Indian Forest Act, 1927/ any other forest Act. A detailed report as per para 1.9 of Chapter 1, Part C of Hand -book of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 is attached).

**The proposal is recommended for diversion of 0.9486 hectares of forest land for the construction of approach road for Moin Quarry site in respect of Ani Forest Division. The project proponent is further required to adhere to the following conditions:-**

1. Ensure that no muck/debris is thrown/dumped on the River/stream bed. The muck be dumped on the designated dumping sites only.
2. Before initiating the work of dumping, sites be protected by erecting protection wall to avoid rolling down of debris.
3. The excavation be carryout in scientific way to avoid rolling down of muck into river/stream.
