JOINT SITE INSPECTION REPORT

A proposal has been received by this office from, **Officer Commanding 109 RCC (GREF)** for diversion (under FCA, 1980) of 22.445 Ha. of Forest land for non-forestry purpose. The subject envisages the use of forest land for **Construction of Operational Track from Pharkin Gali to Puthkhan Gali by 109 RCC GREF in comptt. 6/LB/NH, 23/E/KN, 38/C/KN, 43/NH and 44/NH.**

The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by me on **24.12.2021 to 28.12.2021**. On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the User Agency is a Forest land measuring **22.445 Ha**.
