A proposal has been received by this office from **HPPW Department** for diversion (under FCA - 1980) of **5.31 Hectares** of forest land for non-forestry purpose. The subject envisages the use of forest land for the construction of road from Shamshar to Panei. The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by me on dated **08.07.2020**.

On inspection of the site, it is found that land required by the user agency is a forest area measuring **5.31 Hectares**.

The requirement of forestland as proposed by the user agency in Col.2 of Part-1 is unavoidable and is barest minimum required for the project.

2. Before initiating the work of dumping sites be protected by erecting protection wall to avoid rolling down of debris to the stream.
3. The excavation be carryout in scientific way to avoid rolling down of muck into stream.
