The Senior Engineer, (TLC) Powergrid Parli Transmission Ltd. has submitted the proposal for diversion of 27.846 ha. of forest land for construction of 765 KV D/C Warora-Parli Transmission Line in Pandarkawada, Yavatmal and Pusad Forest Divisions in Yavatmal District and Hingoli Forest Division. The details of forest land proposed for diversion is as given below: -

The forest land comprising of 14.077 ha in the proposal in Compartment no.154, survey no.99 in village Vedshi, Tal. Relegaon, Dist. Yavatmal belongs to FDCM Ltd. The N.O.C for the same has been given by the FDCM Ltd vide letter No.521, dt.11/5/2017.

The proposal has been initiated by Senior Engineer, (TLC) Powergrid Parli Transmission Ltd. for construction and laying of 765 KV D/C transmission line from Warora to Parli. NTPC Limited is establishing coal based Gadarwara Super Thermal Power Station of 2 x 800 MW generation project at Gadarwara, Narsinghpur District in the State of Madhya Pradesh. This transmission belt is very essential in order to facilitate import of power from Generation Hub at Gadarwara STPS of NTPC to cater the requirement of State of Maharashtra. The project is administratively approved by Ministry of Power, Government of India vide letter No. 11/18/2014-PG (RECTPCL-Gadarwara Part-B) dated 10/12/2014. The route for this transmission line as proposed by Senior Engineer, (TLC) Powergrid Parli Transmission Ltd., is only feasible route and the forest land required is the barest minimum. The total route length of the transmission line is 347 Kms, out of which 4.156 Km length is passing through Reserve Forest, Revenue Forest of 3 Villages under Pandharkawda Forest Division, 1 village in Yavatmal Forest Division, 2 villages in Pusad Forest Divison and 1 village in Hingoli Forest Division. The total non forest area involved in the project is 2290.312 Ha. The B:C ratio of the project is 92.46:1. Site inspection reports by (i) Deputy Conservator of Forests, Pandharkawda Forest Division, Pandharkawda enclosed on page no. 69 to 70 (ii) Deputy Conservator of Forests, Yavatmal Forest Division, Yavatmal enclosed on page no. 71 to 73 (iii) Deputy Conservator of Forests, Pusad Forest Division, Pusad enclosed on page no. 74 and (iv) Divisional Forest Officer, Hingoli Forest Division, Hingholi enclosed on page no. 75.

II, Gut no.26/2 of Bhategaon Beat under Hingoli Range and it is contiguous to forest area, suitable for afforestation and free from encroachment and encumbrances.
- The User Agency has submitted the certificates of Collector, Yavatmal and Collector Hingoli under Schedule Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dweller's (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act 2006 issued vide their letters No.AK/WS/425/2017, dt. 25/5/2017 and letter No. WS/land/1-CR-33, dt.21/3/2017 in prescribed format Form- I as per Government of India guidelines dated 5/7/2013.
- 17) The Deputy Conservator of Pandharkawda, Pandharkawda Forest Division, Pandharkawda, (ii) Deputy Conservator of Forests, Yavatmal Forest Division, Yavatmal, (iii) Deputy Conservator of Forests, Pusad Forest Division, Pusad (iv) Divisional Forest Officer, Hingoli Forest Division, Hingoli and the Chief Conservator of Forests (T), Yavatmal Circle have recommended the proposal for diversion of 27.846 ha. of forest land.

In view of this, the proposal is recommended for approval under section - 2 (ii) of FCA-1980 subject to the following conditions –

- i) The legal status of the land required will remain unchanged.
- compensatory afforestation will be raised at the cost of the User Agency on 55.692 ha. over degraded forest land (i) Area 53.430 ha in Reserve Forest Comptt, no.774, Survey no.56, Survey no.57, Survey no.58, Survey no.59, Survey no.60 and Survey no.61 of village Rohana, Tal. Digras, Dist. Yavatmal (ii) Area 2.262 ha in Reserve Forest Comptt no. 475 A, Coup no. II, Gut no.26/2 of Bhategaon Beat under Hingoli Range.
- iii) The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than specified in the project.
- iv) The User Agency will defray the cost of Net Present Value of area 27.846 ha of the forest land proposed for diversion.
- v) The Project Authority will defray the additional/revised cost of Net Present Value of forest land as per the latest guidelines of Government of India
- vi) The User Agency will defray the cost of removal of (Pandharkawda Forest Division 1417 + Yavatmal Forest Division 688 + Pusad Forest Division 1282 + Hingoli Forest Division 20) = 3407 trees in the area proposed for diversion. However, only the required and minimum number of trees will be felled.



- vii) If in future, the need arises for felling, pruning or pollarding of any standing trees under the transmission line for maintenance, the User Agency shall obtain necessary permission as per existing guidelines.
- viii) The User Agency will pay the cost of raising herbaceous/ shrubby medicinal plants under the transmission lines including its nursery and planting cost, wherever feasible in accordance with the scheme prepared by Forest Department.
- ix) Width of right of way for the transmission line shall be limited to 67 m.
- x) All conditions as stipulated in the guidelines under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 shall be strictly followed.
- xi) The user agency shall install circuit breakers at suitable places besides maintaining necessary ground clearance to prevent electrocution of wild animals;
- xii) All necessary precautions should be taken to protect the area from fire.
- xiii) All other conditions as may be mandatory under relevant Acts, Rules and guidelines shall be complied with by the user agency.

It is therefore, requested that Government of India may kindly be moved for approving the Proposal for diversion of 27.846 ha. of forest land for construction of 765 KV D/C Warora-Parli Transmission Line in Pandarkawada, Yavatmal and Pusad Forest Divisions in Yavatmal District and Hingoli Forest Division., under section 2 (ii) of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.

- compensatory afforestation will be raised at the cost of the User Agency on 55.692 ha. over degraded forest land (i) Area 53.430 ha in Reserve Forest Comptt, no.774, Survey no.56, Survey no.57, Survey no.58, Survey no.59, Survey no.60 and Survey no.61 of village Rohana, Tal. Digras, Dist. Yavatmal (ii) Area 2.262 ha in Reserve Forest Comptt no. 475 A, Coup no. II, Gut no.26/2 of Bhategaon Beat under Hingoli Range.
- iii) The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than specified in the project.
- iv) The User Agency will defray the cost of Net Present Value of area 27.846 ha of the forest land proposed for diversion.
- v) The Project Authority will defray the additional/revised cost of Net Present Value of forest land as per the latest guidelines of Government of India
- vi) The User Agency will defray the cost of removal of (Pandharkawda Forest Division 1417 + Yavatmal Forest Division 688 + Pusad Forest Division 1282 + Hingoli Forest Division 20) = 3407 trees in the area proposed for diversion. However, only the required and minimum number of trees will be felled.
- vii) If in future, the need arises for felling, pruning or pollarding of any standing trees under the transmission line for maintenance, the User Agency shall obtain necessary permission as per existing guidelines.
- viii) The User Agency will pay the cost of raising herbaceous/ shrubby medicinal plants under the transmission lines including its nursery and planting cost, wherever feasible in accordance with the scheme prepared by Forest Department.
- ix) Width of right of way for the transmission line shall be limited to 67 m.
- x) All conditions as stipulated in the guidelines under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 shall be strictly followed.
- xi) The user agency shall install circuit breakers at suitable places besides maintaining necessary ground clearance to prevent electrocution of wild animals;
- xii) All necessary precautions should be taken to protect the area from fire.
- xiii) All other conditions as may be mandatory under relevant Acts, Rules and guidelines shall be complied with by the user agency.
