

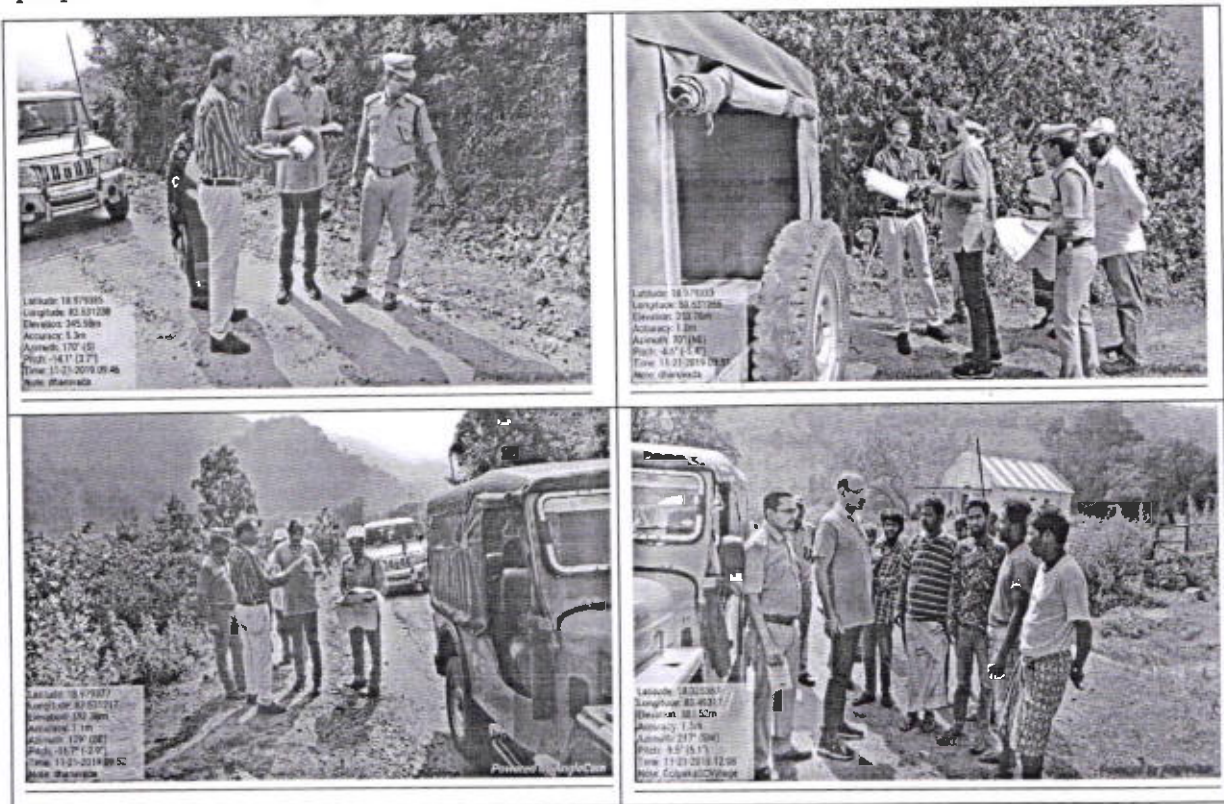
Inspection notes of Sri G.Lakshman, S.F.S., Divisional Forest Officer, Vizianagaram on the road proposals received from the user agency i.e., Executive Engineer, R & B., Parvathipuram for improvement to the road from Kurupam-Muliguda road to Beerupadu via., Deruwada in G.L.Puram mandal of Pujariguda, Goipaka beats, Komarada section, Parvathipuram Range on 21.11.2019

Inspected the proposed improvements to the road from Kurupam-Muliguda road to Beerupadu via Deruwada of G.L.Puram mandal on 21.11.2019 accompanied by the Dy. Executive Engineer, R&B., Parvathipuram along with Forest Range Officer, Parvathipuram (i/c) and the concerned staff. The proposed improvements on the existing road from 8/0 km to 24/600 in Vizianagaram District starting from Deruwada village to Beerupadu. The total length of the improvements proposed is 16.60 kms from Kurupam-Muliguda road to Beerupadu via Deruwada, out of which 8200 meters length is falling inside the R.F., covering (3) Reserved Forests i.e., Deruwada R.F., with 2410 meters in Compt Nos.150, 151, Thatchidi R.F. with 1280 meters in Compt Nos.146, & 149 and Goipaka R.F., with 4510 meters in Compt Nos. 141, 142 143 & 144. The proposed improvements with width is 6.00 meters. The total Forest area to be diverted is 4.92 hectares. The improvements to the proposed road was also surveyed by the D.G.P.S., and authenticated by the G.I.S. wing, O/o Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests, A.P., Guntur in Rc.No.1160/2017/FCA-3(i), dt: 08.12.2018. The starting G.P.S. readings at 8/00 with N 18.97993, E 83.53125 and ends at km 19/510 with G.P.S. readings N 19.05437 and E 83.48279. I have also checked the intermediate G.P.S. coordinates with reference to D.G.P.S. survey and found tallied.

During the inspection I found no trees are falling on the 6 meters width of the proposed improvements of the road for the entire length of the road proposed in Reserved Forest and out side Reserved Forest. There is no tree growth along the road proposed and the crown density on the proposed width of the road is 0.1. During the course of inspection the villagers of Atchaba, Pusabadi, Rasabadi, Goipaka, Gandapaka, Kuthesu, Dabbalaguda, Beerupadu, Srirangapadu, Ladda have approached and requested for this improvements to the existing road for their day to day movement to hospitals, mobility for their children to schools and for marketing their Agricultural products. This improvement is essential for the movement of all the Departmental officers to implement the Government schemes and all activities to the Tribal community residing in the interior villages and to bring them into the main stream. Due to the existing Katcha road the villagers are suffering a lot to bring their pregnant women to the Hospitals and still carrying the patients by "DHOLI" from hill top villages to the plain villages.

There is no violation of work taken place and the required Forest area is unavoidable and no endangered and unique species of Flora and Fauna found in the proposed area and no protected / Archeological Heritage importance in this locality.



The District Collector, Vizianagaram has furnished the certificate (Annexure-I) Form-I regarding the completion of process for identification and settlement of Rights under F.R.A. for this improvement of road proposal and also stated that this proposal does not involve Recognized Right of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre Agricultural Communities.
