


**SITE INSPECTION REPORT OF CHIEF CONSERVATOR OF FOREST,
CHENNAI CIRCLE, CHENNAI ON 21.06.2018**

The proposal submitted is for diversion of land in Thirutheri Reserve Forest of Chengalpattu Range of Chengalpattu Forest Division for Erection of 230 KV DC transmission line from Cuddalore to Veerapuram, I had inspected the site on 21.06.2018. It is a liner stretch of land in Thirutheri Reserve Forest to a length of 1100 mts and width of 46 mts involving 5.06 Ha. Five towers will be erected in the linear stretch of 1100 mts. Trees are available along the linear stretch and they will have to be removed for erection of transmission line which are part of raised plantations. This transmission line is important to provide assured power supply to meet the growing needs of people and industrial development in Kancheepuram District.

I recommend the proposal for diversion of 5.06 Ha for the erection of transmission line as will not cause much disturbance to wildlife and will not affect the eco system and as it required to meet the growing power needs in Kancheepuram District.
