2.0 The proposal for laying of 700 mm underground MIDC MS Pipeline with concrete Encasing for regular water Supply line from MIDC water Treatment Plant, Poynad to GAIL (India) Limited, User for PDH PP Plant of Tadwagale, Dalvi Khoroshi, Kune and Beloshi Villages of Taluka Alibag, Dist. Raigad in Alibag Forest Division in the State of Maharasthra. The User Agency is planning to set up GAIL Petrochemical Complex Prject at Usar wherein a 500 KTPA Propane Dehydrogenation Unit (PDH) integrated with Polypropylene Unit (PPU) is proposed to be set up. The feedstock propane shall be imported from JNPT port and a cryogenic terminal shall be set up at Uran for propane storage. From Uran the Propane shall be pumped through a cross country pipeline to USAR for processing. The proposed project shall benefit from the existing land in possession of GAIL as well as coastal location of the existing facility for both propane import, storage and product evacuation, nearby port facility, proximity to highways and ease of getting environmental clearance. - 4.2 The site inspection report of the Deputy Conservator of Forests, Alibag Forest Division, Alibag is enclosed on page No.32 to 34.
- 4.3 No alternate alignment is possible and the forest land required is lowest minimum. (P/21)
- 4.4 The area belongs to Eco-value class-I having density is 0.2 (P/27).

- 4.6 The area involved in the project does not form part of any existing National Park, Wildlife Sanctuary, Nature Reserve etc. (P/26)
- 4.7 Proposed project is not likely to affect any monumental site of cultural, historical, religious, archeological or recreational importance. (P/25)
- 4.8 There is no violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. (P/22)
- 4.9 Proposed project is 13.85 km. away from the boundary of the Protected Area (Phansad Wildlife Sanctuary) and 13.75 Km. from the boundary of the Eco-Sensitive Zone of Phansad Wildlife Sanctuary. Proposed area is not falling in Eco-Sensitive Zone of Phansad Wildlife Sanctuary. (P/29)

## 7.00 In view of this, the proposal is recommended for approval under the section -2 (ii) of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 subject to the following conditions: -

7.1 The legal status of the forest land required will remain unchanged.

- 7.2 Forest land will be handed over only after required non-forest land for the project is handed over to the User Agency.
- 7.3 Compensatory Afforestaton :
  - a) Compensatory afforstation shall be taken up by the Forest Department over 7.00 ha. degraded forest land of Reserved Forest in Compt. No.168 of Village Vadgaon, Tal. Alibag, Dist. Raigad at the cost of the user agency. As far as possible, a mixture of local indigenous species shall be planted and monoculture of any species may be avoided.
- 7.4 The cost of compensatory afforestation at the prevailing wage rates as per compensatory afforestation scheme and the cost of survey, demarcation and erection of permanent pillars if required on the CA land shall be deposited in advance with the Forest Department by the project authority. The CA will be maintained for 10 years. The scheme may include appropriate provision for anticipated cost increase for works scheduled for subsequent years.
- 7.5 NPV:
  - a) The State Government shall charge the Net Present Value (NPV) for the 3.4151 ha. forest area to be diverted under this proposal from the User Agency as per the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 30/10/2002, 01/08/2003, 28/03/2008, 24/04/2008 and 09/05/2008 in IA No.566 in WP (C) No.202/1995 and as per the guidelines issued by the Ministry vide letters No.5-1/1998-FC (Pt.II), dated 18/09/2003 as well as letter No.5-2/2006-FC, dated 03/10/2006 and 5-3/2007-FC, dated 05/02/2009 in this regard.
  - b) Additional amount of the NPV of the diverted forest land, if any, becoming due after finalization of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on receipt of the report from the Expert Committee, shall be charged by the State Government from the User Agency. The User Agency shall furnish an undertaking to this effect.
- 7.6 User Agency shall restrict the felling of trees to minimum number in the diverted forest land and the trees shall be felled under the strict supervision of the State Forest Department and the cost of felling of trees shall be deposited by the User Agency with the State Forest Department.
- 7.7 All the funds received from the user agency under the project shall be transferred/deposited to CAMPA fund only through e-portal (<u>http://parivesh.nic.in/</u>)
- 7.8 The complete compliance of the FRA, 2006 shall be ensured by way of prescribed certificate from the concerned District Collector.
- 7.9 The pipeline shall be laid down 1.5 meter below the ground and after lying down of pipe line the ground will be leveled.
- 7.10 The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of Central Government.
- 7.11 No labour camp shall be established on the forest land.

- 7.12 Sufficient firewood, preferably the alternate fuel, shall be provided by the User Agency to the labourer after purchasing the same from the State Forest Department or the Forest Development Corporation or any other legal source of alternate fuel.
- 7.13 The boundary of the diverted forest land shall be suitably demarcated on ground at the project cost, as per the directions of the concerned Divisional Forest Officer.
- 7.14 No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for transportation of construction materials for execution of the project work.
- 7.15 The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the project proposal.
- 7.16 The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agencies, department or person without prior approval of Government of India.
