i i	Short narrative of the proposals and project/scheme for which the forest land is required	The Tadoba Andhari Tiger Reserve (TATR) area surrounded by Chandrapur Forest Division. The Geographical area of TATR is 625.40 Sq. km. and spread over 4 Tahsils viz. Bhadrawati, Chimur, Sindewa and Chandrapur. The TATR is rich in biodiversity witiger as its flagship species. There are six villages in TAT namely Botezari, Kolsa, Palasgaon (Singru), Jamin Navegaon (Ramdegi) and Rantalodhi which needer rehabilitation in order to provide inviolate space to tig and other important species. Therefore Governmed decided to rehabilitate all these villages outside TATR. Botezari, Jamni, Navegaon, (Ramdegi), Kolsa (Par Villages are already rehabilitee and situated outside TATR. The rehabilitation work of village Palasgae (Singru) is going on in Comptt No 11 of Warora Range Chandrapur Forest Division. The people of Rantalodhi have selected the Comptt. No 186 of Bramhapuri Forest Division near village Golabh for their rehabilitation. Subsequently the proposal und Forest Conservation Act 1980 for Comptt No.186 ar 180.00 ha. has been sent to Government of India fidiversion of said land in to non forest land for rehabilitation of Rantalodhi village. Accordingly Govt. India has approved the proposal vide letter F.No. 40/2001-FC dated 16.01.2002. But the people Rantalodhi have denied for rehabilitation of their villa Rantalodhi in Comptt. No. 186 as there is no war sources. So also the said area is not suitable feetablishing/constructing artificial tank for Irrigation Cultivation. Thereafter the people of Rantalodhi have selected to the cultivation.
		Comptt. Nos. 13 & 14-B in Warora Range of Chandrap Forest Division and submitted the resolution passed by t Gramsabha stating that they are ready and willing rehabilitate in the said Comptt. No. 14B in Warora Ran of Chandrapur Forest Division.

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4.		As per the NTCA guidelines, the core areas of tiger reserve are to be kept inviolate. Consistent with this policy, relocating Rantalodhi village as per their choice in Compartment No.14-B of Warora range would prove beneficial for tiger conservation in TATR landscape.
		Therefore proposal for diversion of 374.75 ha. is hereby submitted under Forest Conservation Act.1980 for taking up rehabilitation work in Compartment No. 14-B of Warora range in Chandrapur Forest Division.

III	Cost of the Project	The project under consideration is to rehabilitate 244 families. The Central Government will provide a sum of 24.40 crores as per NTCA guidelines 2008 under Beneficiary Oriented Scheme of Central Government.
iv`	Justification for location the project in the forest area	As there is no non forest land available in the district and a certificate to that extent has been issued by the Collector, Chandrapur, this forest land is selected by the affected persons in consultation with the forest department for rehabilitation. The selected site is near to Taluka place, Warora and hence the fruits of development will accrue to the rehabilitated families in the shortest possible time.
V	Cost benefit analysis	As per NTCA guidelines inviolate spaces are to be created in the core area of tiger reserves and therefore, relocation of villages outside tiger reserve is necessary. Villages located within the protected areas (Tiger Reserve) are deprived of development because of their remoteness. They also suffer considerable losses because of wild animals entering into cultivated fields resulting in crop depredation and livestock predation. Sometimes Human beings are also either killed or injured leading to conflict situations. Relocation of the villages will help establishment of model village supported with civic amenities. They will also have better access to market for the sale of agriculture produce. People will have also easy access to medical facilities. The whole life of the people will be improved substantially.
