Early in the morning proceeded to Mangalgiri Beat and inspected the proposed diversion area proposed for formation of B.T road from Brahmanandapuram to NH-5 and the following observations were made.

- a) The length of proposed road is 850m with a width of 10m.
- b) A metal road is already existing in the proposed area and it was informed by the local people and staff that the kutcha road was formed long back i.e more than 50 years back by the M/s ACC cements established in 1933.
- c) Near the village i.e at the starting point of the proposed road around 200 m of BT road was laid which is in damaged condition. The exact period of laying of road could not be ascertained and the staff were unable to tell the facts.
- d) The road is bifurcating the RF by leaving small strip i.e (8m-10m vide) on the northern side. There may be chances of encroaching the strip. If we change the alignment to boundary of the RF, several trees need to be felled. As already Kutcha road is existing the User Agency may be instructed to provide chain link fence or compound wall along the boundary of the RF, to protect the RF area.
- e) Along southern boundary of the road the electricity dept. laid electrical poles and electrical line (11KV) by violating the provisions of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.
- f) Adjacent to the road one church was constructed inside the RF.


