




Sir,

The undersigned is directed to say that the Competent Authority of Ministry of Health & Family Welfare has approved the site at Village Manethi, District Rewari, Haryana offered by the State Government for establishment of new All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:

- a) The land use of site is non-agriculture under Aravali plantation scheme, therefore the change in land use would be required. The state govt. has to meet the requirement of department of environment and forest for this and arrange the change in land use.
- b) The State Govt. to provide required 20MVA of power supply from two independent sources and 1.5 MLD (15 lakh litre per Day) potable water supply to the site.
- c) The State Government will upgrade the existing approach road (two km length) to four lane road keeping in view the increase traffic movement with establishment of AIIMS.
- d) The state govt. will provide encumbrance free site and arrange necessary statutory permission and approvals for removal of trees. State Government will also facilitate removal and cutting of trees at the time of actual construction.
- e) State Govt. will also provide necessary arrangement for disposal of treated sewage and effluent generated by the Institute.

2. It is, therefore, requested to provide the commitments as specified above and intimate the same to this Ministry for taking further necessary action in the matter.
