Sub: Diversion of 125.9 ha.(Renewal) in Kondapuram RF of Aswapuram Range, Paloncha Division for Manuguru OCP-II (Phase-III) in favour of SCCL, Manuguru – Status of compliance of conditions - Reg.

Ref.1.MoEF Ir. No. 8-56/2004-FC, dtd. 14.7.2008 2.GOAP GOMS No. 97, dtd. 5.5.1997. 3. PCCF office file No.8033/2003-F1. 4.PCCF Ir. No.20725/2011-F1, dated 03.12.2012.

Kind attention is invited to the reference 2nd cited. The status of condition-wise compliance is furnished as below:

Condition No.(1): Legal status of the forest land shall remain unchanged.

Compliance: Yes, Legal status is remained unchanged.

<u>Condition No.(2)</u>: Where ever possible and technically feasible, the User Agency shall undertake afforestation measures in the blanks within the lease area, as well as along the roads outside the lease area diverted under this approval, in consultation with the State forest department at the project cost.

<u>Compliance:</u> Since the forest land is diverted for Open Cast, the quarry operations are in progress in an area of 20.8 ha. out of the total area of 125.9 ha. OB dumping activity is in progress in 105.1 ha. Reclamation was completed over an area of 31.5 ha and plantation is also done. In remaining area after completion of reclamation plantation will be taken up.

Condition No.(3): The following activities shall be undertaken by the State forest department at the project cost:

<u>Condition(i)</u>: Proper mitigative measures to minimize soil erosion and chocking of streams shall be prepared.

<u>Compliance:</u> Garland drains (24 km) are provided to prevent the soil erosion all along the quarry boundary, settling ponds are maintained to prevent the soil being carried to near by streams.

<u>Condition(ii)</u>: Planting up of all vacant land and dumps with suitable species to arrest soil erosion and its protection.

<u>Compliance</u>: Plantation has already done over an area of 31.50 ha in the diverted land. Further Plantation is being done as soon as the dumps height reached to the maximum level as per the mining plan.

<u>Condition</u> (iii): Construction of a series of check dams and toe walls along the contour on the hill slopes to avoid rolling down of the excavated material.

<u>Compliance:</u> 1.4 km. length of Garland drains along haul road and one check dam have been constructed in the diverted area and the same are being maintained.

Condition (iv):It will be done 100 mt. belt around the diverted forest land in addition to safety zone.

<u>Compliance:</u> All sides except a small portion towards south are covered under mining operations. Towards south, the tree density is more than 0.4. Hence, no possibility to raise plantation in 100 mtrs. Belt area.

Condition No.(4): The period of diversion under this approval shall be twenty (20) years subject to possession of valid lease by the User Agency under the MMDR Act, 1957 so that it shall be co-terminus.

<u>Compliance:</u> Yes. Lease under MM(D&R) Act is for 20 years, valid upto 09.04.2027. Application submitted to the Asst. Director of Mines & Geology, Bhadradri Kothagudem (Dist) for lease extension up to 09.04.2057 as per the provisions of Mineral Concession(amendment) Rules,2021 and it is under process.

Condition No.(5): (i) The User Agency shall take up planting work on the static dumps during the advance mining operation.

(ii) All the dumps will be fully reclaimed by afforestation immediately as per letter approved EMP & Mine closure plan.

<u>Compliance:</u> (i) Plantation is completed in an area of 31.50 ha. reclamation in the remaining area plantation will be taken up after complication of reclamation.

ii) Plantation is being carried out as per approved EMP. So far plantation in 31.50 ha. has been done. Remaining area will be afforested after completion of mining.

<u>Condition No.(6):</u> Any tree felling shall be done only when it is absolutely necessary and unavoidable, and that too under strict supervision of the State Forest Department.

<u>Compliance:</u> Since the sanctioned forest land was for Opencast mining, the land was handed over after extracting the tree growth at the time of original diversion.

Condition No.(7): No damage to the flora and fauna of the area shall be caused.

<u>Compliance:</u> The Forest land is diverted for mining activity. SCCL has prepared a comprehensive mitigative measures plan for total Manuguru area and deposited an amount of Rs.16.68 crores to the Chief Wild Life Warden for wild life conservation and management plan.

<u>Condition No.(8):</u> Reclamation Plan shall be strictly implemented which shall be monitored regularly by the State Forest Department.

Compliance: Reclamation is being done as per the approved E.M.P.

Condition No.(9): It shall be ensured that no labour-camps are set up inside the forest area.

Compliance: No labour camps are set up in the sanctioned forest area.

Condition No.(10): The mining lease area shall be demarcated on ground at the project cost, using four feet high RCC pillars, with each pillar inscribed with the serial number, forward and backward bearings and distance between two adjacent pillars.

Compliance: The Forest area diversion in the middle of the quarry and surrounded byOB dumping. Pillars cannot be existing.

Condition No.(11): The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the proposal.

Compliance: Yes. Forest land is being used for the purpose for which it is sanctioned

Condition No.(12): Any other condition that the State Government and/or the CCF (Central), Regional Office, Bangalore, may like to impose from time to time for protection and improvement of flora and fauna in the forest area, shall be applicable.

Compliance: Yes.

Kind attention is invited to the reference 1st cited. The status of condition-wise compliance is furnished as below:

Condition No.(1): Legal status of the forest land shall remain unchanged.

Compliance: Legal status is remained unchanged.

Condition No.(2): The land identified for the purpose of C.A. shall be notified by the State Government as RF under Section 4 or PF under Section 29 of the Indian Forest Act, 1927 or under the relevant Section(s) of the local Forest Act, as the case may be, within a period of six months.

<u>Compliance:</u> SCCL identified equivalent extent of 175.69 ha. of non-forest land in Lachapet (V), Velerupadu (M) of Kukkunoor range of Paloncha Forest Division and the same has been handed over and mutated in favour of Forest Department on 29.02.2008. The Notification details may be obtained from the District Forest Officer, Bhadradri kothagudem.

Condition No.(3)(a): Wherever possible and technically feasible, the User Agency shall undertake afforestation measures in the blanks within the lease area as well as within 100 Meter radius from the lease area inside RF if density is lesser than 0.4 and maintain it till the life of the project, in consultation with the State Forest Department.

<u>Compliance:</u> Since the forest land diverted is for Opencast mining, it is not feasible to take up plantation in the area during mining operations. Regarding plantation with in 100 Mtrs. radius, it is to state that the south, East & West sides are covered in quarry area.

However Gorrepeta vagu also exists on North & West sides and further natural forest more than 0.4 crown density.

Condition No.(3)(b): The User Agency shall raise and maintain the Afforestation including enrichment plantation over surface area diverted as in in-principle approval.

<u>Compliance:</u> As the area diverted is for Opencast mining, plantation will be taken up on this land after completion of quarry operations and reclamation of the void area.

Condition No.(3)(c): Fencing, protection and regeneration of the safety zone area (7.5 meters strip all along with outer boundary of the mining lease area) shall be done at the project cost and a half times the area under safety zone, shall also be done at the project cost. Besides this, afforestation on 100 meter radius of mining lease granted in degraded forest land if density is less than 0.4/enrichment plantation shall be taken up by the user agency in consultation with the Forest Department.

Compliance: A trench was dug-up in east and north sides for protection. SCCL paid Rs.10.12 lakhs to Forest Dept. towards raising cost of plantations in 1½ times safety zone area of 5.3 ha. and protection and re-generation of safety zone area of 3.53 ha. The 100 mtrs radius area adjacent to the diverted forest land is having very thick forest growth having 0.4 crown destiny.

Condition No.(4): The period of diversion under this approval shall be twenty (20) years subject to possession of valid lease by the User Agency under the MMDR Act, 1957 so that it shall be co-terminus.

<u>Compliance:</u> Yes. Lease under MM (D&R) Act is for 20 years, valid up to 21.11.2028. Application submitted to the Asst. Director of Mines & Geology, Bhadradri Kothagudem (Dist) for lease extension up to 22.11.2058 as per the provisions of Mineral Concession(amendment) Rules, 2021 and it is under process.

<u>Condition No.(5)</u>: Additional amount of the NPV of the diverted forest land, if any, becoming due after finalization of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India shall be charged by the State Government from the User Agency. The User Agency shall furnish an undertaking to this effect.

<u>Compliance:</u> SCCL deposited Rs.1410.79 lakhs towards NPV with Forest Department vide DD No.04170, dated 03.11.2008 of SBH, Manuguru and also given undertaking to pay additional amount, if any, after finalisation of the same by Hon'ble Supreme Court.

Condition No.(6): Any tree felling shall be done only when it is absolutely necessary and unavoidable.

<u>Compliance:</u> Since the sanctioned forest land is for OC mining, Forest Dept extracted tree growth and handed over the land to SCCL.

Condition No.(7): No damage to the flora and fauna of the area shall be caused.

<u>Compliance:</u> SCCL has prepared a comprehensive mitigative measures such as wild life conservative management plan for total Manuguru area and paid Rs.16.68 crores to forest dept

Condition No.(8): Reclamation Plan shall be strictly implemented which shall be monitored regularly by the State Forest Department/ Regional Office, Bangalore.

<u>Compliance:</u> Reclamation is being carried out as envisaged in the approved EMP and the report is being submitted once in 6 months to Regional office, MOEF.

Condition No.(9): It shall be ensured that no labour camps are set up inside the forest area.

Compliance: No labour camps are set up in the diverted forest land.

Condition No.(10): The mining lease area shall be demarcated on ground at the project cost, using four feet high RCC pillars, with each pillar inscribed with the serial number, forward and backward bearings and distance between two adjacent pillars.

Compliance: 4' high RCC Pillars (16 Nos.) were constructed inscribing the required details

Compliance: Forest land is being used only for the purpose indicated in the proposal.

Condition No.(12): All other conditions mentioned in the in principle approval shall be complied with.

<u>Compliance:</u> The conditions stipulated in in-principle approval have already been complied with and final clearance was granted.

<u>Condition No.(13):</u> Any other condition that the CCF (Central), Regional Office, Bangalore/ State Government may impose from time to time for protection and improvement of flora and fauna in the forest area, shall also be applicable.

Compliance: No such additional condition was stipulated.

Kind attention is invited to the $2^{\rm nd}$ reference cited. The status of condition-wise compliance is furnished as below:

Condition No.I: Legal status of the diverted Forest land shall remain unchanged.

Compliance: Yes. Legal status of Forest land remained unchanged.

<u>Condition No.II</u>: The Non-Forest land which is transferred and mutated in favour of the State Forest Department for the purpose of raising compensatory afforestation shall be declared as Reserved Forest under Section-4 or Protected Forest under Section-29 of the Indian Forest Act, 1927 or under the relevant Section(s) of the local Forest Act.

<u>Compliance:</u> The user agency has transferred 10.50 Ha of Non- forest land for compensatory afforestation purpose to State Forest Dept. at Rasannagudem – 4.233 Ha. (part of 495.09 Ha.), Mulakalapalli Mandal, Paloncha division and Janampeta village – 6.267 Ha. (Part of 55.13 Ha.) handed over to Forest Dept. Total Area – 10.50 Ha. The above lands have been mutated in favour of Forest Dept. The Notification details may be obtained from Forest department.

<u>Condition No.III</u>: The user agency shall furnish an undertaking to pay the additional amount of NPV, if so determined, as per the final decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

<u>Compliance:</u> An amount of Rs.66,11,800/- deposited with TS CAMPA Account towards NPV and also given an undertaking for payment of additional amount of NPV payable if any as per the Hon'ble Supreme Court has submitted to MoEF&CC

<u>Condition No.IV</u>: The Forest land on surface of the mining lease shall be fenced and afforested by the user agency at the project cost:

<u>Compliance:</u> The forest area proposed for diversion is for mine entries & infrastructure etc., surrounded by a compound wall.

<u>Condition No.V</u>: The period of diversion of the said forest land under this approval shall be for a period co-terminus with the period of the mining lease proposed to be granted under the Mines & Minerals (Development & Regulation) Act, 1957 as amended or the Rules framed there under:

Compliance: Yes, the Lease is granted under MM (D&R) Act 1957 for a period of 21 years. Valid up to 13.12.2031.

<u>Condition No.VI</u>: User Agency either himself or through the State Forest Department, shall undertake gap planting and soil moisture conservator activities to restock and rejuvenate the degraded open forests (having crown density less than 0.4), if any, located in the area within 100m from outer perimeter of the mining lease.

<u>Compliance:</u> The SCCL will prepare a scheme for this purpose and will take up gap planting and soil & moisture conservation activities to restock, rejuvenate and improve the density of the degraded open forests (having crown density less than 0.4), if any, located in the area within 100 meters from outer perimeter of the mining lease.

<u>Condition No.VII</u>: The user agency shall undertake de-silting of the village tanks and other water bodies located within five KM from the mine lease boundary so as to mitigate the impact of siltation, of, such tanks/water bodies, whenever required.

<u>Compliance:</u> SCCL is arranging for de-siltation of tanks and water bodies located within 5 KMs of Mine lease boundary and the same is under process.

<u>Condition No.VIII</u>: The State Government and the user agency shall execute mitigation/ameliorative measures recommended by the Standing Committee of the NBWL at the project cost:

<u>Compliance:</u> This 10.50 Ha. Surface Diversion is required for infrastructural facilities and same is covered with compound wall. For the same project 477.03 Ha. of Underground area is diverted by MoEF Ltr. No.8-71/2009-FC, dated 18.05.2015, the SCCL has deposited an amount of Rs.14,27,16,900/- with Chief Wild Life Warden & Member Secretary, BIOSOT, Hyd. towards the implementation of the Wild Life improvement for landscape between Pakala Wild life Sanctuary, Kinnerasani WLS and Papikondalu National park.

<u>Condition No.IX</u>: To enrich the buffer area and to mitigate the impact of mining, provisions given in the approved action plan for Environmental Management shall be implemented by the State Forest Department at the Project cost:

<u>Compliance:</u> SCCL is taking up these activities. As per the advise of the state forest department.

Condition No.X: The user agency shall undertake mining in a phased manner after taking: due care for reclamation of the mined over area. The concurrent reclamation plan shall be executed by the User Agency from the very first year, and an annual report on implementation thereof shall be submitted to the Nodal Officer, Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, Government of Telangana and the Addl. Pr. Chief Conservator of Forests(Central), Ministry of Environment & Forests, Regional Office(Southern Zone), Bangalore. If it is found from the annual report that the activities indicated in the concurrent reclamation plan are not being executed by the User Agency, the Nodal Officer or the Chief Conservator of Forests(Central) may recommend to the Ministry of Environment & Forests, suitable penal action to be taken against the proponent:

<u>Compliance</u>: The above diversion is requisitioned for infrastructure facilities like roads, office buildings, etc. After closure of the mine the area will be reclaimed.

Condition No.XI: No labour camp shall be established on the forest land:

Compliance: The Forest land will not be used for establishing labour camps.

<u>Condition No.XII</u>: The User Agency shall provide alternate fuel, preferably LPG for at the site so as to avoid any damages pressure on the adjacent forest areas:

<u>Compliance:</u> SCCL is providing free supply of LPG cylinders to all its employees @ 12 Cylinders per annum.

<u>Condition No.XIII</u>: The boundary of the mining lease and safety zone shall be demarcated on ground at, the project cost, by erecting four feet reinforced cement concrete pillars, each inscribed with its serial number, DGPS co-ordinates, forward and back bearing and distance from adjoining pillars:

<u>Compliance</u>: RCC boundary pillars of 4' feet height have been constructed around the Forest area proposed for diversion. Serial No. forward and back bearings and distances from pillar to pillar are written on the pillars.

<u>Condition No.XIV</u>: The Forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the proposal.

Compliance: The Forest land will be used for the purpose for which it is sanctioned.

<u>Condition No.XV</u>: The user agency shall submit the annual self compliance report in respect of the above conditions and also to the conditions stipulated in Stage-I clearance to the State Government and to the concerned Regional Office of the Ministry regularly.

<u>Compliance:</u> SCCL is submitting the annual self compliance report to the Regional Office, Chennai.

<u>Condition No.XVI</u>: Any other condition that the concerned Regional Office of this Ministry may stipulate, from time to time, in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife and

<u>Compliance:</u> SCCL agree to abide by any other condition imposed by State Govt./ Regional Office, MoEF, Chennai from time to time. Condition No.XVII: The User Agency and the State Government shall ensure compliance to provisions of the all Acts, Rules, Regulations and Guidelines, for the time being in force, as applicable to the project.

Compliance: SCCL agree to comply the provisions of all acts, rules regulations and guidelines issued from time to time.

The Nodal Officer, Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. Government of Telangana shall submit compliance report within 6 months from the date issue of the said letter.

Condition No.IV: Following activities shall be ensured by the State Govt. as per approved plan at the project cost:

Condtion(a): Appropriate mitigative measures to minimize soil erosion and choking of streams.

<u>Compliance</u>: As per EMP plan mitigative measures are being taken by constructing rock toe walls and garland drains, Catch drains to minimize erosion and choking of streams.

As provided in the Scheme, Bird nests artificially made out of eco-friendly materials will be procured and used in the area, including forest area and human settlements, adjoining the forest area being diverted for the project.

Condition No.X: Fencing, protection and regeneration of the safety zone area (7.5 meters strip shall be kept within the mining lease boundary and the area of the safety zone shall be part of the total area of mining lease as per the Ministry's guidelines dated 27.05.2015) shall be done within three years at the project cost as per approved scheme. Besides this afforestation on degraded forest land to be selected elsewhere measuring one and a half times the area under safety zone shall also be done at the project cost.

Compliance: The Forest Divisional Officer, Manuguru was requested vide our letter No MNG/EST/F/017/488, dated 30.09.2022 for identification of degraded open forests having crown density less than 0.4. The SCCL will take up the work as and when area is shown to the SCCL by the Forest Department for taking up of gap planting and soil moisture conservator activities.

Condition No.IV: The period of diversion of the said forest land under this approval shall be for a period co-terminus with the period of the mining lease proposed to be granted under the Mines & Minerals (Development & Regulation) Act, 1957 as amended or the Rules framed there under:

Compliance: Yes, the lease under MM&DR Act is for 20 years up to 13.12.2031.

<u>Condition No.V:</u> User Agency either himself or through the State Forest Department, shall undertake gap planting and soil moisture conservator activities to restock and rejuvenate the degraded open forests (having crown density less than 0.4), if any, located in the area within 100m from outer perimeter of the mining lease.



Condition No.(I): Legal status of the diverted forest land shall remain unchanged.

Compliance: Yes, Legal status of Forest land remained unchanged.

<u>Condition No.(II):</u> The user agency shall furnish an undertaking to pay the additional amount of NPV, if so determined, as per the final decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

<u>Compliance</u>: An Undertaking for payment of additional amount of NPV payable if any as per the Hon'ble Supreme Court was submitted to MoEF.

c). Stabilize the overburden dumps by appropriate grading/benching so as to ensure that angles of repose at any given place is less than 28° degrees.

<u>Compliance</u>: Dump stabilization being done with the help of high capacity dozers and over all angle of repose of over burden dump at any place being maintained is less than 28 degrees and certified by mine surveyor.

d). Strict adherence to the prescribed top soil management.

Compliance: The total top soil excavated so far 3.709 M Cum and stacked in 2 No's of stack yards on the surface each stack yard of 1.29M Cum and 0.78M Cum. Top soil dump was sown with Hemanta legume seeds to re grass the area.

Condition No.(VI): The State Government and user agency shall ensure land surrender schedule for surrender of the mined out and biologically reclaimed forest land as per approved mine plan and progressive mine closure plan. The biologically reclaimed forest land will also be surrendered to the State Forest Department as per approved schedule.

<u>Compliance</u>: As mentioned in the schedule of surrender, the forest lands will be surrendered to the State Forest Dept. An Undertaking for surrender of the reclaimed forest land to the State Forest Dept. is also submitted at the time of compliance of Stage-1 conditions.

Condition No.(VII): Fencing, protection and regeneration of the safety zone area (7.5 meters strip all along the outer boundary of the mining lease area as recommended by the State Government) shall be done at the project cost, Besides this afforestation on degraded forest land to be selected elsewhere measuring one and a half times the area under safety zone shall also be done at the project cost:

Compliance: As per the demand issued by the Divisional Forest Officer, Paloncha, the User Agency (SCCL) has deposited an amount of Rs.1.651 lakhs towards fencing, protection and afforestation of 7.5 mtrs. strip all along the boundary of area identified to undertake mining. This is part of total amount of Rs.166.721 lakhs remitted in to CAMPA Account as mentioned under Condition No.II.

Condition No.(VIII): To enrich the buffer area and to mitigate the impact of mining, provisions given in the approved action plan for Environmental Management shall be implemented by the State Forest Department at the project cost.

As on 30.10.2021 total plantation done is 127.54 ha and all the measures to protect environment as envisaged in approved EMP is being implemented.

<u>Condition No.(IX)</u>: Period of diversion of the said forest land under this approval shall be for a period co-terminus with the period of the mining lease proposed to be granted under the Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957, and the Rules framed there under, subject to a maximum period of 30 years.

Compliance: Yes, Mining leases are granted under M&M (D&R) Act and it is valid up to 2035.

Condition No.(X): User Agency either himself or through the State Forest Department shall ensure gap planting and soil & moisture conservation activities to restock and rejuvenate the degraded open forests (having crown density less than 0.4), if any, located in the area within 100 meters from outer perimeter of the mining lease:

<u>Compliance:</u> Except south side, no forest land is existing around three sides of the diverted area. As such, towards south side, SCCL will take up plantation with consultation of State Forest Department.

<u>Condition No.(XI)</u>: The State Government and the user agency shall ensure de-silting of the village tanks and other water bodies located within 5 km from the mine lease boundary so as to mitigate the impact of siltation of such tanks/water bodies, whenever required.

<u>Compliance:</u> There are two village tanks named by Timma Reddy Kunta and Annaram village Tanks are exist on the downstream side of external dump within 5km range. The

proposal of de-silting of the above tanks will be made in consultation with State irrigation dept as well as SCCL Civil dept.

Condition No.(XII): User agency shall ensure mining in a phased manner and take due care for reclamation of the mined over area. The concurrent reclamation plan shall be executed by the User Agency as per the approved mining plan/scheme and an annual report on implementation thereof shall be submitted to the Nodal Officer, Forest (Conservation) Act,1980, State Government and concerned Regional Office of this Ministry. If it is found from the annual report that the activities indicated in the concurrent reclamation plan are not being executed by the user agency, the Nodal Officer or the concerned Regional Office of this Ministry may direct that the mining activities shall remain suspended till such time, such reclamation activities are satisfactorily executed.

<u>Compliance</u>: As on date 42.67 ha of mined out area has reclaimed with 8.41 Mcum of overburden and remaining area will be reclaimed as per the reclamation plan and reports of the same will be submitted to the Regional Office in every six months.

Condition No.(XIII): No labor camp shall be established on the forest land.

Compliance: The Forest land will not be used for establishing labor camps.

<u>Condition No.(XIV)</u>: User agency shall provide firewood preferably alternate fuel to the laborers and the staff working at the site so as to avoid any damage and pressure on the adjacent forest areas:

Compliance: SCCL is providing free supply of LPG to all its employees @ 12 cylinders per annum.

Condition No.(XV): Boundary of the mining lease and safety zone shall be demarcated on ground at the project cost, by erecting four feet high reinforced cement concrete pillars, each inscribed with its serial number, forward and back bearing and distance from pillar to pillar;

<u>Compliance</u>: RCC boundary pillars of 4' feet height have been constructed around the Forest area proposed for diversion. Serial Nos. forward and back bearings and distances from pillar to pillar are written on the pillars 37 No's of RCC Pillar of 4 feet height were constructed around the mine boundary including forest land.

Condition No.(XVI): Forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the proposal.

Compliance: The Forest land will be used for the purpose for which it is sanctioned.

<u>Condition No.(XVII)</u>: Any other condition that the concerned Regional Office of this Ministry may stipulate, from time to time, in the interest of conservation, protection ;and development of forests & Wildlife.

<u>Compliance</u>: SCCL will abide by the conditions if any imposed by Regional Office South Eastern Zone, Chennai, in the interest of conservation, protection and development of Forest and Wild life.

<u>Condition No.(XVIII)</u>: The user agency shall submit the annual report on compliance to conditions stipulated in the approval conditions and also the condition stipulated in Stage-1 clearance to the State Government and the concerned Regional Office of this Ministry and

<u>Compliance</u>: The annual report on compliance to conditions stipulated in the approval conditions and also the condition stipulated in stage-I clearance to the State Government and the concerned Regional Office of this Ministry is being submitted time to time.

<u>Condition No.(XIX)</u>: User agency and the State Government shall ensure compliance to provisions of the all Act, Rules, Regulations and Guidelines for the time being in force as applicable to the project.

<u>Compliance</u>: SCCL agree to comply the provisions of all Acts rules regulations and guidelines issued from time to time .An under taking is also enclosed

Condition No.(i): Legal status of the forest land shall remain unchanged.

Compliance: Yes, Legal status remained unchanged.

Condition No.(ii): Compensatory Afforestation will be raised over equivalent non-forest land at the cost of the project. The non-forest land identified for this purpose should be, handed over to the Forest Department and notified as Protected Forests before the release of forest lands now being diverted by these orders.

Compliance: C.A. land 412.6 ha. was handed over in Karimnagar (East) Division and C.A. charges amounting to Rs.59.324 lakhs deposited with the Forest Department on 26.12.1987, 13.8.1993 and 29.6.1994. The said land was declared as protected forest vide G.O.Ms. No.270 dated 29.7.1989.

Condition No. (iii): Mined over area should be reclaimed within a period of five years.

Compliance: An area of 308.4 ha. was only handed over by Forest Department. The mining is completed in 308.40 ha. Remaining area of 104 ha. was not taken over and accordingly Forest Dept. was informed vide SCCL letter No.EM/FL/6/88, Dtd. 19.6.1992. This was accepted by MoEF, GOI Rf.No.8-73/2005-FC, dt. 6.11.05. The refilling in 308.40 ha. is under progress. All along the OB deck on non-working side, garland drains (2 km), deck drains (1 km) added with settling tanks (4 Nos.), were taken up to arrest soil erosion besides planting in about 171.6 ha. with miscellaneous species to stabilize the Overburden dumps.

Condition No.(2)(ii): Fencing protection and regeneration of the safety zone area (7.5 meters strolled along the outer boundary of the mining lease area) shall be done at the project cost. Besides the afforestation on degraded forest land to be selected elsewhere, measuring one and a half times the area under Safety zone, shall also be done at the project cost.

Compliance: SCCL paid an amount of Rs.49.375 lakhs vide DD No.449843, dated 01.03.2008 towards cost of taking up enrichment planting, protection and regeneration in Safety zone area and 1 1/2 times of Safety zone area.

Condition No.(2)(iii): Wherever possible and technically feasible, the User Agency shall undertake afforestation measures in the blanks within the lease area, as well as along the roads outside the lease area diverted under this approval, in consultation with the State Forest Department at the project cost.

Compliance: SCCL has taken up avenue plantation all along the roads i.e., 5.2 km plantation was done in Manuguru area. Condition No.(2)(iv): User Agency shall raise and maintain the enrichment plantation over Surface area diverted as in in-principle approval.

Compliance: As mentioned under condition No.2(iii) SCCL has deposited Rs.49.375 lakh into the CAMPA towards enrichment of plantation

Condition No.(3): Following activities shall be undertaken by the State Forest Department at the project cost:

Condition No.3(i): Proper mitigation measures to minimize soil erosion and choking of streams shall be prepared.

Compliance: Garland drains (6.7 km), toe walls (1.0 km), settling ponds (4 Nos.) 4 check dams and deck drains (5 km) besides putting 20 cribs were provided in OC mines area to prevent soil erosion and choking of the streams.

Condition No.3(ii): Planting up of all vacant land and dumps with suitable species to arrest soil erosion and its protection.

Compliance: Plantation 191.8 Ha. has been done on dump slopes to arrest soil erosion in OC areas.

Condition No.3(iii): Construction of a series of check dams and toe walls along the contour on the hill slopes to avoid rolling down of the excavated material. It will be done 100 mt. belt around the diverted forest land in addition to the safety zone.

Compliance: Four check dams and 1.0KM length toe wall is constructed. Regarding plantation in 100 mirs, belt in forest area from lease boundary, towards east there is no RF land beyond the lease boundary up to Bayyaram road. Towards West & North West, the adjacent areas are either already diverted or proposed for diversion for extension of existing mines.

Condition No (4): The period of diversion under this approval shall be twenty (20) years subject to possession of valid lease by the User Agency under the MMDR Act, 1957 so that it shall be coterminus.

Compliance: Yes, Lease under MM (D&R) Act is for 30 years and valid till 22.07.2035.

Condition No (5)(i): The User Agency shall take up planting work on the static dumps during the advance mining operations.

Compliance: Static dumps area is assessed and plantation is being done. As on date out of 200 ha. of statutory dumps 191.8 ha. of plantation has being done.

Short No (5)(ii):All the dumps shall be fully reclaimed by afforestation immediately after closure of finine in the shortest possible period under supervision of the State Forest Department.

compliance: Since mining is in active stage, afforstation will be done after completion of quarry activities and reclamation of the mines. However, so far in around 5 ha, block plantation was done.

Condition No.(6): Any tree felling, shall be done only when it is absolutely necessary and unavoidable, and that too under strict supervision of the State Forest Department.

Compliance: No tree felling is done except in the areas which were approved for surface use. Extraction of tree growth was done by Forest Dept., before it was handed over to SCOL.

Condition No. (7): No damage to the flora and fauna of the area shall be caused.

Compliance: The Forest land was diverted for opencast mining. Hence, damage to Flora is unavoidable. The Fauna in the area moved to the adjacent area.

Kind attention is invited to the reference 1st cited. The status of condition-wise compliance is furnished as below:

Condition No.(1): Legal status of the diverted forest land shall remain unchanged.

Compliance: Legal status is remained unchanged.

Condition No.(2)(i): Compensatory Afforestation shall be raised and maintained by the State Forest Department at the project cost.

Compliance: Initially the Manuguru Mining lease is involving 1312 ha of Forest land and 874 hectares of Non-Forest land. Out of 1312 ha of forest land, 406.15 ha is underground rights, 444.45 ha was handed over before FC Act,CA charges were paid and 461 ha is converted in to opencast mines, during that time SCCL has handed over the CA Land, the CA Land details are furnished here with

Condition No.(2)(ii): Fencing protection and regeneration of the safety zone area (7.5 meters strolled along the outer boundary of the mining lease area) shall be done at the project cost. Besides the afforestation on degraded forest land to be selected elsewhere, measuring one and a half times the area under Safety zone, shall also be done at the project cost.

Compliance: SCCL paid an amount of Rs.49.375 lakhs vide DD No.449843, dated 01.03.2008 towards cost of taking up enrichment planting, protection and regeneration in Safety zone area and 1 1/2 times of Safety zone area.

Condition No.(2)(iii): Wherever possible and technically feasible, the User Agency shall undertake afforestation measures in the blanks within the lease area, as well as along the roads outside the lease area diverted under this approval, in consultation with the State Forest Department at the project cost.

Compliance: SCCL has taken up avenue plantation all along the roads i.e., 5.2 km plantation was done in Manuguru area. For raising plantation in blanks on the surface, as per the damand raised by Forest Dept SCCL deposited Rs.49.375 lakhs in to CAMPA Account in the year vide DD bearing no 449843, dated.01.03,2008.

Condition No.(2)(iv): User Agency shall raise and maintain the enrichment plantation over Surface area diverted as in in-principle approval.

Compliance: As mentioned under condition No.2(iii) SCCL has deposited Rs.49.375 lakh into the CAMPA towards enrichment of plantation

Condition No.(3): Following activities shall be undertaken by the State Forest Department at the project cost:

Condition No.3(i): Proper mitigation measures to minimize soil erosion and choking of streams shall be prepared.

Compliance: Garland drains (6.7 km), toe walls (1.0 km), settling ponds (4 Nos.) 4 check dams and deck drains (5 km) besides putting 20 cribs were provided in OC mines area to prevent soil erosion and choking of the streams.

Condition No.3(ii): Planting up of all vacant land and dumps with suitable species to arrest soil erosion and its protection.

Compliance: Plantation 191.8 Ha. has been done on dump slopes to arrest soil erosion in OC areas.

Condition No.3(iii): Construction of a series of check dams and toe walls along the contour on the hill slopes to avoid rolling down of the excavated material. It will be done 100 mt. belt around the diverted forest land in addition to the safety zone.

Compliance: Four check dams and 1.0KM length toe wall is constructed. Regarding plantation in 100 mirs, belt in forest area from lease boundary, towards east there is no RF land beyond the lease boundary up to Bayyaram road. Towards West & North West, the adjacent areas are either already diverted or proposed for diversion for extension of existing mines.

Condition No (4): The period of diversion under this approval shall be twenty (20) years subject to possession of valid lease by the User Agency under the MMDR Act, 1957 so that it shall be coterminus.

Compliance: Yes, Lease under MM (D&R) Act is for 30 years and valid till 22.07.2035.

Condition No (5)(i): The User Agency shall take up planting work on the static dumps during the advance mining operations.

Compliance: Static dumps area is assessed and plantation is being done. As on date out of 200 ha. of statutory dumps 191.8 ha. of plantation has being done.

Short No (5)(ii):All the dumps shall be fully reclaimed by afforestation immediately after closure of finine in the shortest possible period under supervision of the State Forest Department.

compliance: Since mining is in active stage, afforstation will be done after completion of quarry activities and reclamation of the mines. However, so far in around 5 ha, block plantation was done.

Condition No.(6): Any tree felling, shall be done only when it is absolutely necessary and unavoidable, and that too under strict supervision of the State Forest Department.

Compliance: No tree felling is done except in the areas which were approved for surface use. Extraction of tree growth was done by Forest Dept., before it was handed over to SCOL.

Condition No. (7): No damage to the flora and fauna of the area shall be caused.

Compliance: The Forest land was diverted for opencast mining. Hence, damage to Flora is unavoidable. The Fauna in the area moved to the adjacent area.
