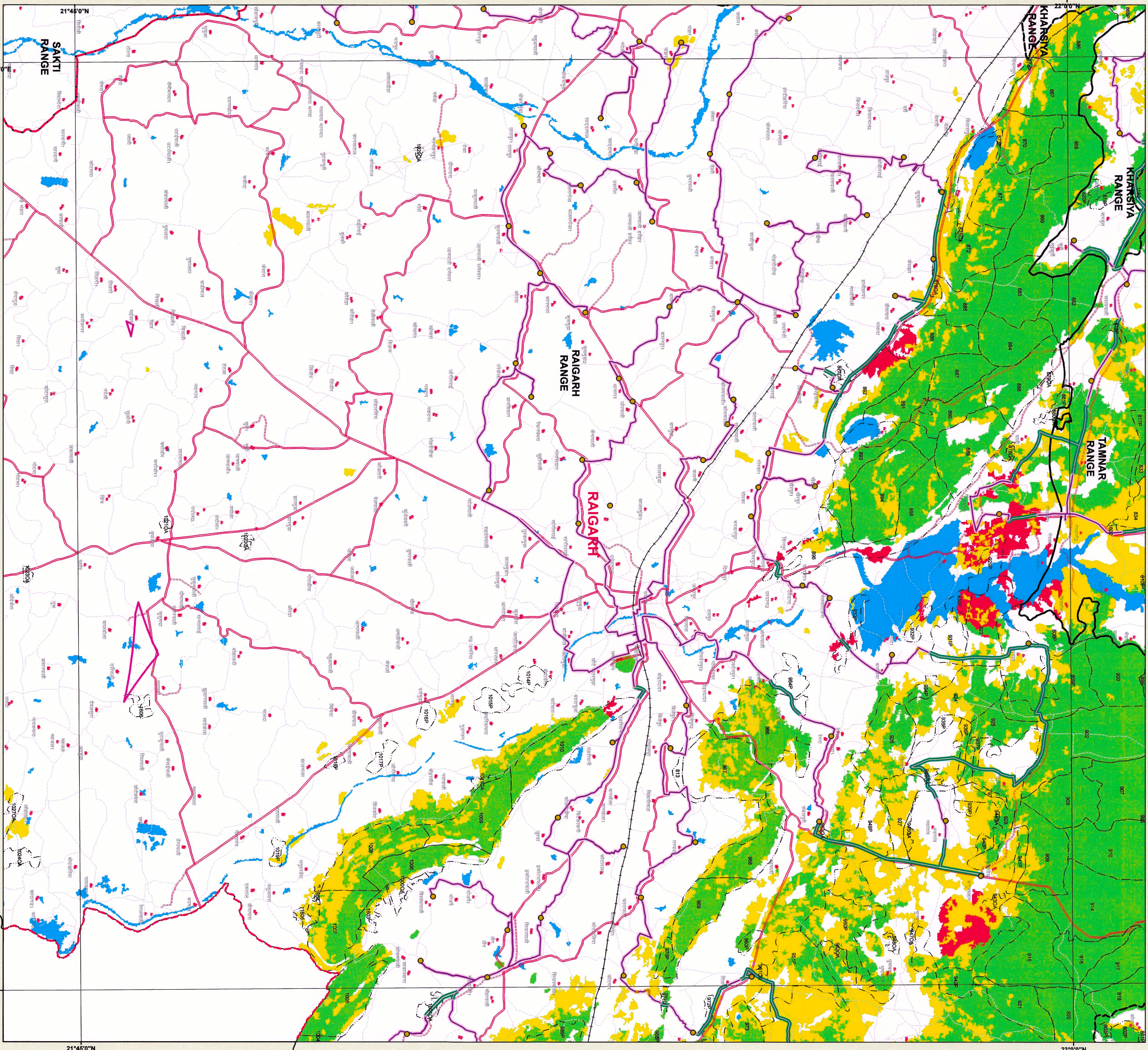

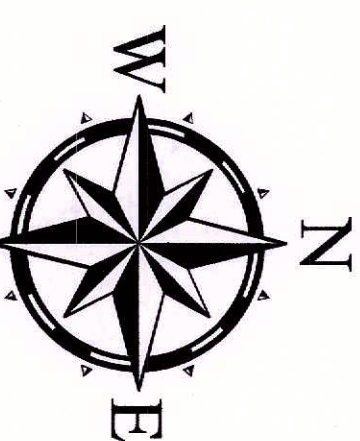

Very Dense Forest: - All land with tree cover (including Mangrove cover) of canopy density of 70 % and above
Moderately Dense Forest: - All land with tree cover (including Mangrove cover) of canopy density between 40% and 70% above
Open Forest: - All land with tree cover (including Mangrove cover) of canopy density below 40%
Scrub: - All forest lands with poor tree growth mainly of small or stunted trees having canopy density less than 10%
Non Forest: - Any Area not included in the above classes.
