

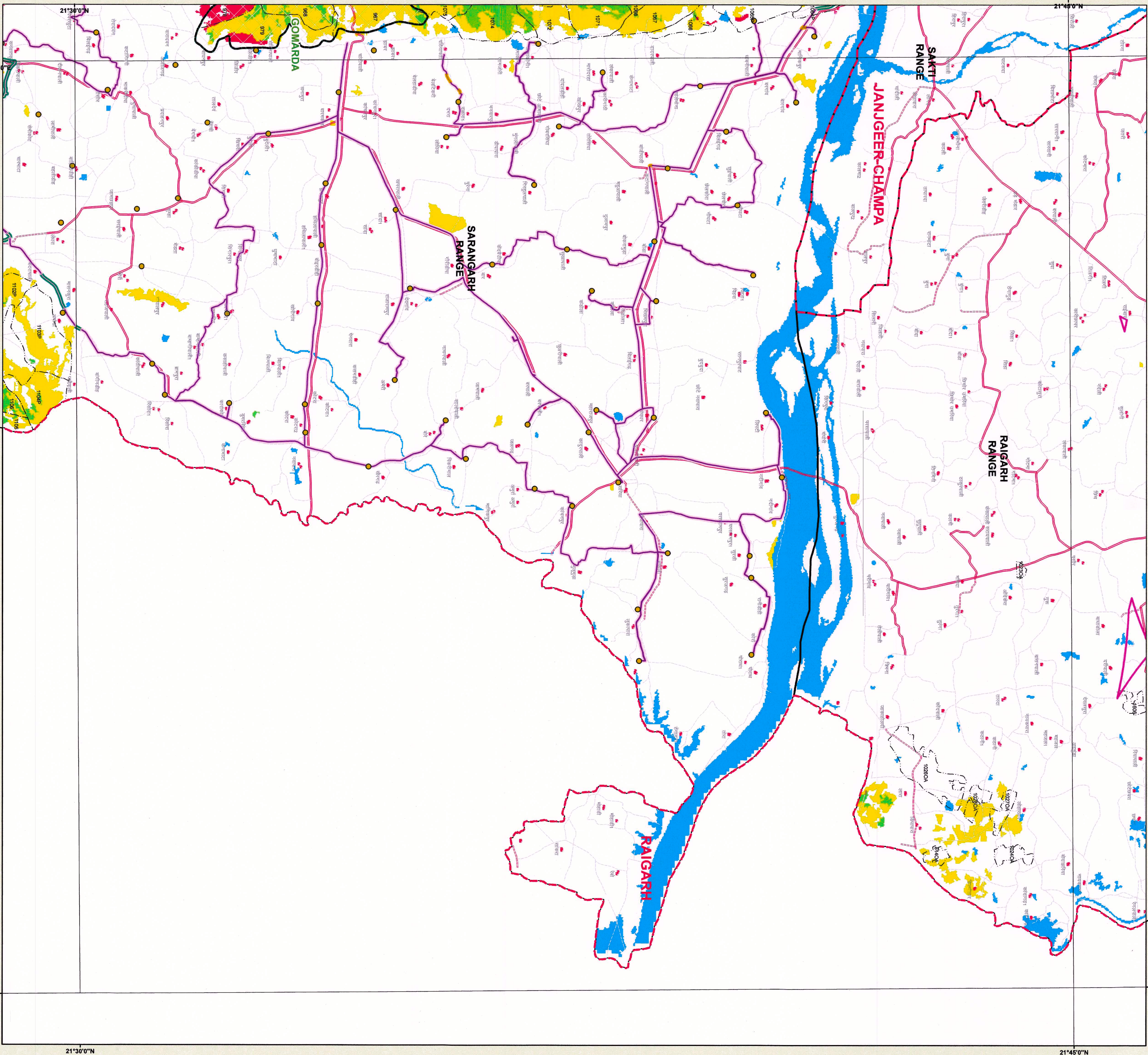

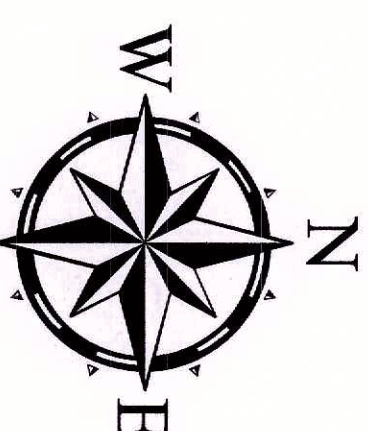

cover) of canopy density of 70% and above.
Dense Forest:- All land with tree cover (including Mangrove cover)
of canopy density of 60% and above.
Moderately Dense Forest:- All land with tree cover (including Mangrove cover)
of canopy density of 50% and above.
Open Forest:- All land with tree cover (including Mangrove cover)
of canopy density of 40% and above.
Scrub:- All forest lands with poor tree growth mainly of small or
medium trees having canopy density less than 10%.
Non Forest:- Any area not included in the above classes.
