
In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MOEF) Government of India's letter No. 11-9/98-FC(pt.) dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MOEF Issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act,2006 ('FRA' for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes read with MOEF's letter dated 5th February 2013 wherein MOEF issued certain relaxation in respect of linear projects. It is certified that 15.044 hectares of forest land proposed to be diverted in the favour of Power Grid Corporation of India Ltd., (A Govt. of India Enterprise), (name of user agency) for construction of +/-800KV HVDC Power Transmission Line from Raigarh (Chattisgarh) to Pugalur (TN) (purpose for diversion of forest land) in Peddapalli district falls within jurisdiction of Lonkakesharam Village of Ramagiri Mandal, Peddapalli district.

It is further certified that:

- (a) The complete process for Identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 15.044 hectares of Forest area proposed for diversion. However, the proposed area of diversion in RF does not fall in the scheduled tribe area and therefore does not attract the provision of RoFR Act. A copy of records of consultations and meetings of the Gram Sabha, Sub-Division Level Committee [as annexure].
- (b) The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3 (2) of the FRA have been completed and the Gram Sabhas have given their consent to it;
- (c) The proposal does not involve recognized rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-Agricultural communities.

Consequent on which identification and settlement of rights under FRA does not arise.
