Sub: Uttar Pradesh Core Road Network Development Project proposed from World Bank Loan- – Application for diversion of Protected Forest (PF) for the project Improvement and Upgradation of Bahjoi to Gajruala section of State Highway No.-51(SH-51) from Km 58.500 to Km 107.000 in Sambal district and from Km 107.000 to Km 137.500 in Amroha (J.P.Nagar) district of Uttar Pradesh- fresh application


Dear Sir

The Government of Uttar Pradesh has launched a road development programme called “**Uttar Pradesh Core Road Network Development Project (UPCRNDP)**” with an objective of developing and providing high speed and safe road network in the state by improving state roads including State Highways (SH) and Major District Roads (MDR) with assistance of World Bank (WB) funding. Under the UPCRNDP the road section from Bahjoi to Gajruala section of SH-51 from Km 58.500 to 137.000 has been selected for widening to standard two lane configuration with 1.5 m paved shoulder and 1.0 m earthen shoulder on both side. The project section from Km 58.500 to Km 107.000 falls in Sambal district and from Km 107.000 to Km 137.500 falls in Amroha (J.P.Nagar) district of Uttar Pradesh.

We wish to highlight that we had submitted the proposal for diversion of 63.20 ha of forest land in for the above project vide forest proposal No.: FP/UP/ROAD/7586/2014. In the original proposal the chainage of district boundary of Sambal and Amroha district was mentioned as Km 110.000 of SH-51 in Sambal. During joint verification, it has been revealed that the actual chainage of the project section is from Km 58.500 to Km 107.000 falls in Sambhal district and from Km 107 to Km 137.500 of SH-51 falls in Amroha district. As advised by DFO and yourself, we have withdrawn the old proposal.

As per advice of the Forest Department, in the meeting held in the office of secretary Forest, Govt. of U.P. on 12/03/15. we have withdrawn the earlier combined proposal. In view of the above background, we

are resubmitting herewith the fresh application for Forest Clearance with corrected chainages for the above project in the specified FORM-A. You are requested to kindly process the Forest Clearance proposal at the earliest as this project is in top priority list for development of road network in the state.
