Hence, the proposal for diversion of 25.31 Ha of Forest land for upgradation of existing NH 30 from Km.169.770 to 236.150 of Vijayawada to Jagadhalpur section to two lane with paved shoulders in the state of A.P., is recommended subject to the following conditions:-</p> <p>1) The felling of trees may be restricted to the extent only where in necessary to remove.</p> <p>2) Translocation of trees is to be done of desirable species in the girth class below 90 Cms. The translocation charges are to be borne by the User Agency including maintenance charges up to the settlement of the translocated trees.</p> <p>3) The felled material(trees, fuel, timber and pulp if any) is the property of the Department and the user Agency shall bear the felling, transportation charges etc.,</p>
