With reference to the above communication, we respectfully submit the detailed clarifications and supporting information sought by the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change (MoEF&CC) regarding the existing alignment and widening of the approach road to Sri Sairam Educational Institutions.

Reason for shift in alignment	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Consistency of Alignment: Our institution confirms that no new road has ever been constructed; the alignment has remained unchanged since its inception.• Organizational Background: Sapthagiri Educational Trust is a registered charitable trust (TN Societies Registration Act, 27/1975). Sri Sairam Engineering College was established in 1995 with the mission of providing quality higher education.

		<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Historical Context: On 17.10.1994, prior to the college's establishment, the Trust formally petitioned the District Forest Officer, Kancheepuram, for permission to utilize the existing North-South pathway through the Nallur Reserved Forest to connect to the Tambaram-Somangalam Highway.• Original Usage: This route was a long-standing, pre-existing foot, cattle, and cart track used locally for years before our lease. Following approval, the existing track was simply widened.• Regulatory History: Our original lease application (1994) and subsequent diversion application (2000) under Section 2 of the Forest Conservation (FC) Act, 1980 (for 0.84 ha) pertained exclusively to this same alignment. Stage-II clearance was issued on 13.12.2004 by the Ministry of Environment & Forests (Regional Office, Southern Zone, Bangalore) and Tamil nadu State Government Issued G.O on (Annexure-1).• Verification by Authorities: The location of this proposal has been verified by the Tahsildar, RDO, District Collector, Forest Ranger, and District Forest Officers (Annexure II).• Evidence of Non-Deviation: We continue to utilize the same alignment as originally approved. To confirm there has been no deviation, we have enclosed supporting documentation including Survey of India maps, Google Earth imagery (dating back to 2002), DGPS survey maps, Revenue records, and Forest Department field inspection reports (2014, 2017, 2018, and 2021). As per Survey of India Toposheet 1970-71 (before 1980) no cart track mark north south direction not marked in Nallur Reserved Forest area (Annexure III)

		<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Official Rectification: Notably, following an inspection on 04.07.2014, the District Forest Officer reported that allegations of a change in alignment were unsupported by field facts and requested a formal rectification of records (Ref. No. 8573/D dated 25.07.2014). (Annexure IV)• Single Access Point: From 1995 to date, only one approach road has served the campus. This was reaffirmed by the District Collector (Proc. No. A2/4800/2001 dated 23.03.2001) and multiple DFO inspections between 2014 and 2021 (Annexures V).• Government Acceptance: The Government accepted these findings and issued orders confirming that the road assigned to our Trust was duly approved and must be accurately reflected in the Nallur RF maps.• Current Status: The road currently in use follows the exact North-South alignment approved by both State and Central Government authorities.• Reason for Widening: In accordance with State and Central Government orders, our Trust constructed a 12-meter-wide, 700-meter-long road in 2006, following the same alignment that has existed since 1995. Although we received sanction for a 12-meter width, we initially formed only a 7.5-meter bitumen-top road. This was done out of a sincere commitment to protecting the natural green cover of this forest area.• This history demonstrates that our Trust has no intention of violating any norms or regulations, neither during the initial use of the lease road in 1995 nor following the formation of the approved access road for the Sri Sairam Engineering College and our six-institution campus complex.

		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • However, to ensure mandatory compliance with CMDA (Chennai) norms for plan approval and land-use reclassification, the approach road width must be no less than 18 meters. Consequently, we have submitted our proposal for the diversion of 0.64 hectares of forest land in the Nallur RF. This is strictly required to fulfil the statutory requirement of widening our existing approved access road. (Annexure VI) • Conclusion: There has been no shift, change, or deviation in the road's alignment. A detailed technical note featuring reconciliation tables is enclosed for further clarity.
2.	Submission of revised proposal:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Our applications in 1994 and 2000 pertained strictly to the existing alignment, for which Stage-II clearance was granted on 13/12/2004. The current application for widening (0.64 ha) is an extension of that original proposal. As the project maintains the same footprint, there has been no shift or deviation in the alignment; therefore, a revised proposal is not required. • For the 0.84 ha previously diverted, we have already fulfilled all statutory obligations, including <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Providing double the extent of CA land (1.68 ha) from our own patta land • Transfer of this land to the Forest Department (Chengalpattu District - S.No. 216 & 218) • Payment of NPV Rs. 5,46,000 • Payment of Afforestation Cost Rs. 1,83,800 (Annexure- VII)

However, all current KML submissions accurately reflect the original, unchanged North-South alignment and the existing 7.5m bitumen road, while accounting for the proposed widening. The latest revised KML file is enclosed in digital format for your perusal. The kml file uploaded in FORM A (Part-1) C. <u>Maps of forest land proposed to be diverted section</u> and DGPS Points and Top sheet map also.(Annexure-X)</p>

Sir,
Kindly refer to the State Government's letter no. 19730/FR11/2001-2 dt. 18.12.01 & 11.8.03 seeking prior approval of Central Government in accordance with Section 2 of Forest Conservation Act 1980 for the above project.

After careful consideration of the proposal of the State Government, I am directed to convey Central Government's approval in principle (Stage I) for diversion of 0.84 ha. of forest land in Nallur Reserved Forest in Tambaram Range, Chengalpattu Division in Kancheepuram Dist. for access road to the Engineering College run by M/s. Sapthagiri Educational Trust subject to the following conditions:-

i) The non forest land identified _____ for raising penal compensatory afforestation ^{over} an extent of 1.68 ha. shall be transferred and mutated in favour of forest department. The non forest land shall be declared as PF/RF under Indian Forest Act 1927.

ii) The cost of raising penal compensatory afforestation over an extent of 1.68 ha. degraded forest land shall be recovered from the user agency.

2. After receipt of the compliance report on the above conditions final approval will be accorded and forest land should not be transferred to the user agency prior to issue of final approval.

3. This approval shall be valid for a period of 5 years. In the event of non-compliance of the above conditions, this approval shall automatically stand revoked.



Kindly refer to the State Govt.'s letter No. 19730/FR11/2001-2 dated 18-1-2-2001 and 11/8/2003 seeking prior approval of the Central Government in accordance with Section "2" of F(C) Act, 1980 for the above project. The stage I approval to the project was accorded by the Central Government vide letter of even No. dated 15-9-2003. The State Government vide letter No. 19730/FR.10/2001-13 dated 1-11-2004 has reported the compliance to the conditions stipulated by Central Government in the Stage I approval.

After careful consideration of the proposal of the State Government, I am directed to convey the Central Government's approval (stage II) for diversion of 0.84 ha. of forest land in Nallur Reserved Forest in Tambaram Range, Chengalpattu Division in Kancheepuram district for access road to the Engineering College run by M/s. Sapthagiri Educational Trust, subject to the following conditions.

- (i) The legal status of the forest land shall remain unchanged.
- (ii) The penal compensatory afforestation shall be raised over 1.68 ha. of identified non forest land at Sy. No. 216 and 218/part of Perunthandalam village, Chengalpattu taluk, Kancheepuram district at the cost of the user agency. The State Government shall obtain prior permission of Central Government for change of location and schedule of compensation afforestation site, if any.

- (iii) The non forest land for penal compensatory afforestation shall be notified by the State Government as R.F. under Section "4" or P.F under Section "29" of the Indian Forest Act, 1927 or the State Act within a period of 6 months and Nodal Officer (Forest Conservation) shall report compliance within six months.
- (iv) The State Government shall charge the Net Present Value of the forest area diverted under this proposal from the user agency as per the orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 30-10-2002 and 1-8-2003 in I.A. No. 566 in WP(C) No. 202/95 and the guidelines issued by Ministry vide letter No. 5-1/1998-FC(Pt.II) dated 18-9-2003 and 22-9-2003 in this regard.
- (v) The State Government shall deposit all the above funds realized towards Compensatory Afforestation and Net Present Value with the Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management & Planning Authority (CAMPA) which has already been constituted and notified by the Central Government on 23-4-2004. Till such time CAMPA intimates the Head of Accounts for depositing funds, the funds will be maintained in the form of fixed deposits in the name of Nodal Officer or concerned Divisional Officer of the State Government. The funds realized towards the N.P.V and the C.A. shall not be utilized by the State Government.
- (vi) The total forest area utilized for the project shall not exceed 0.84 ha. In case the land is not used for the stipulated purpose, then the area will be resumed by the Forest Department.
- (vii) Any other conditions to be stipulated by the State Government/PCCF, Tamil Nadu in the interest of conservation of forests.

ORDER:

The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests has sent proposal under section 2 of the Forest(Conservation) Act 1980 for diversion of 0.84 ha. of forest land in Nallur R.F. in Tambaram Range, Chengalpattu Division, Kancheepuram District to M/s. Sapthagiri Education Trust for laying access road to reach the Engineering College in Kancheepuram District.

2. The proposal was examined and forwarded to Government of India, Ministry of Environment and Forests, Bangalore for obtaining concurrence under section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.

3. In the letter third read above, Government of India, Ministry of Environment and Forests (FC Division), Bangalore have conveyed their (Stage-II) approval for the diversion of the above forest land mentioned in para 1 above subject to certain conditions.

4. The Government have decided to accept the conditions stipulated by Government of India and direct that an extent of 0.84 ha. of forest land in Nallur R.F. Chengalpattu Division, Kancheepuram District be diverted to M/s. Sapthagiri Education Trust, for laying access road to reach Engineering College run by M/s. Sapthagiri Education Trust in Kancheepuram District subject to the following conditions:

- (i) The legal status of the forest land shall remain unchanged.

5. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests is requested to pursue action with reference to the conditions stipulated in para 4 above and send a report to Government in due course.



1. I am directed to state that the state Principal Chief Conservator of Forests has sent proposal under Forest (C) Act, for diversion of 0.84 ha. of forest land in Hallur Reserved Forest in Tenbarani Range, Chengalpattu Division in Kanchipuram District for access road to the Engineering College run by M/s. Sathagiri Educational Trust.

2. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests has reported that the forest area required for the above project is 0.84 ha. The user agency has stated that all other alternative for the purpose have been explored and the demand for the required area is the minimum of the forest land. The Collector, Kanchipuram District has given a certificate that no alternative suitable non-forest land is available to run the Engineering College except the reserved land now proposed.

3. The District Forest Officer, Chengalpattu Division has stated that no cutting or felling of trees is involved in the forest area to be diverted for the purpose.

4. Though the question of Compensatory Afforestation does not arise in this regard, as the area to be diverted is less than one ha., the user agency has identified an area of 1.68.0 ha. of non forest land in S.No.216 an extent of (3.50 acres) 1.48.0 ha. and S.No.218 an extent of (0.50 acre) 0.20.0 ha. total 1.68.0 ha. in Chengalpattu Taluk for compensatory afforestation. The District Forest Officer has stated that the non-forest land identified for compensatory afforestation is suitable for raising tree species and is in a compact block and continuous to Bajur Reserved Forest. The compensatory afforestation cost worked out by District Forest Officer comes to Rs.1.85 Lakhs.

5. The State Principal Chief Conservator of Forests has also reported that the user agency has given the undertaking for:-

- (a) paying annual lease rent as fixed by Forest department
- (b) cost of compensatory afforestation as fixed by Forest Department; and
- (c) bearing the cost along with any escalation for exploitation of trees.

6. I am directed to enclose the proposal for diversion of 0.84 ha. of forest land with reference to the above purpose and to request that the concurrence of Government of India under section 2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 may kindly be obtained and communicated to this Government early.

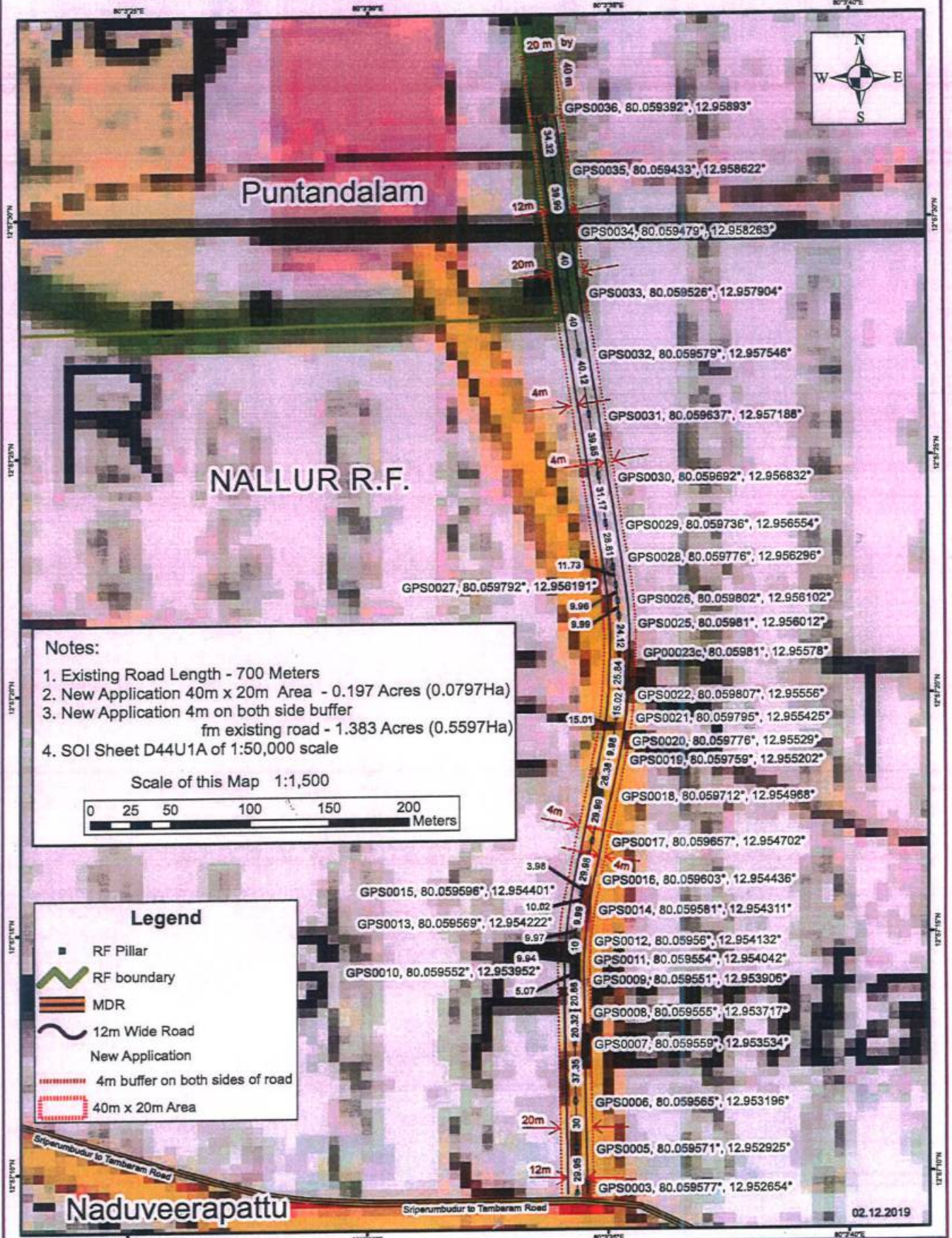

MR. W. S. WHITESIDE.

Read—the following letter from A. PINTO, Esq., Forest Settlement-officer, Madura, Tinnevely, Chingleput and Coimbatore Districts, to the Collector of the Chingleput District, dated Kollegal, 10th September 1889; Reference on No. 524-G.:—

I have the honor to report the conclusion of the settlement of the proposed Nallur reserved forest, block No. 39, of your district.

2. This block lies chiefly in the Conjeeveram and partly in the Saidápet taluk, and takes in portions of four villages, viz., Nallur, Somangalam, Naduvirappattu and Puntandalam. It comprises an area of acres 936.75 or about 1.46 square miles. The notification under section 4 of the Forest Act appeared in the *Fort St. George Gazette*, dated 18th September 1888, and the proclamation under section 6 of the Act was published in the District Gazette, dated 6th October 1888. Three months' time was allowed for preference of claims from the date of publication of the proclamation which expired on the 6th January 1889. The settlement was taken in hand in January 1889 and closed by the end of that month. But the claim preferred to public rights of way could not be disposed of before the 5th August 1889, as several references to the District Forest-officer had to be made to elicit information required by the recent orders of the Board of Revenue. I had then to wait for a sketch-map of the block to accompany this report, which was received on the 6th instant. Hence the delay in the submission of the report.

3. Ten other claims were preferred, of which, seven were to patta lands lying outside the forest and were dismissed; one was to land cultivated without authority by the claimant; it was rejected. Another was to land bought in by Government at a revenue sale and subsequently put up to auction. As the second sale was after the proclamation under section 6 was published in the District Gazette, the claim was held invalid under section 7 of the Act and rejected. The last claim was by the President, District Board, to a quarry lying inside the forest. As the quarry is at a distance from Local Fund Road and did not come within the rule prescribed for quarries lying at the sides of roads in G.O., No. 702, dated 10th October 1888, I informed the President that I could not deal with it, and that access would have to be allowed as a matter of concession by an executive order.

4. No alteration was made in the boundary at settlement. The boundary description has been revised by giving the sides of fields and village boundaries abutting the block.

The boundary cuts through the following fields, viz., No. 1 of Nallur, 1 and 2 of Somangalam, 366 of Naduvirappattu and 426, 427 and 430 of Puntandalam; but all by straight lines duly described.

5. The sketch-map furnished by the District Forest-officer is defective in various points, of which a separate memorandum is attached. I beg that these defects may be caused to be rectified before submitting the sketch to the Board of Revenue with the report. If possible, I beg that the sketch, when rectified, be sent to me for verification.

6. I beg that three months' time be allowed for promulgation of the notification under section 16 as required by the Act, from the probable date of its appearance in the *Fort St. George Gazette*.

With reference to the Forest Settlement-officer's memorandum of defects in the sketch-map, the District Forest-officer points out that what is required by the Board is a sketch-map of a proposed reserve illustrative of its boundaries set forth in the draft notification and of the admitted rights if any (*vide* paragraph 3 of Board's Proceedings, No. 251, dated 2nd May 1889), and that the perfection which the Forest Settlement-officer seeks cannot be expected from clerks who have had no professional training.

4. In paragraph 2 of the Forest Settlement-officer in letter, the total area of the forest is entered 936.75 acres instead of 937.52 acres. This increase was duly communicated to the Forest Settlement-officer in letter, No. 609-Forest, dated 21st January 1889.

5. A list of fieldwar areas included in the forest is attached.

I submit that in the references 3rd & 4th cited. Reports sought on the following points:-

- (1) Report on Government of India in letter No.F(C)A/11.2/118/TN/RC/2064 dated 19.01.2007 which has been again communicated in this C.No.TS3/28217/2000 dated 07.05.2014.
- (2) Action taken report relating to allegation and Vigilance and Anti-Corruption.
- (3) Detailed report on the recent proposal for widening the existing road involving diversion of 0.56 ha duly analyzing the matter in depth and after field inspection.

2) I submit my remarks on the above points:-

- (1) Report on Government of India in letter No.F(C)A/11.2/118/TN/RC/2064 dated 19.01.2007 which has

been again communicated in this C.No.TS3/28217/2000 dated 07.05.2014.

The Government of India, Ministry of Environment and Forests letter dated 19.01.2007 requested factual report regarding black topping of road without clearance under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 for the project diversion of 0.84 hectares of forest land in Nallur Reserved Forest for laying access road to reach Engineering College run by M/s. Sapthagiri Educational Trust in Kancheepuram District. In the said letter was also observed that during the monitoring of the project undertaken by Deputy Conservator of Forests (Central) on 21.12.2006, it was intimated by the local forest officials that the forest area used for approach road presently is not the same area diverted as per the proposal and requested to send the factual report. As submitted in detail in my letter No.8573/D dated 10.02.2014, the Sapthagiri Educational Trust was using a path way from the year 1995 and given a proposal for diversion of forest land on 24.04.2000. In Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Head of Forest Force) Ref.No.TS3/23827/2000 dated 10.11.2001 proposal was sent to Government for permission of the Government of India under Section 2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for diversion of 0.84hec of forest land in Nallur Reserved Forests for laying access road to reach Engineering College for the length of 700 metres and width of 12 metres. The Government in letter No.19730/FR.11/2001 dated 18.01.2001 sent proposal to Government of India for diversion of 0.84hec of forest land for concurrence of Government of India under Section 2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. The Government of India in letter No.NII dated 15.09.2003 conveyed the approval in principle for diversion of 0.84 hec in Nallur Reserved Forests for Access Road to the Engineering College run of Sapthagiri Educational Trust subject to the conditions as prescribed therein.

The Sapthagiri Educational Trust complied the conditions laid in the Government of India references. The Sapthagiri Educational Trust informed in their letter dated 14.08.2004 that they black topped the road for the conduct of International conference. The Government of India in the letter F(C)A/11.2/118/TN/RC dated 13.12.2004 conveyed the Central Government approval for diversion of 0.84 ha of forest land in Nallur Reserved Forest in Tambaram Range, Chengalpattu Division in Kancheepuram District for access road in the Engineering College run by Ms. Sapthagiri Educational Trust, subject to the conditions as stated therein. The said Government in G.O.Ms.No.83, Environment and Forests Department dated 21.08.2006 issued orders on the same line and in pursuance to the said Government of India orders. This is the factual positions.

The Sapthagiri Educational Trust in representation dated 23.06.2014 has also given detailed reply that the existing road is the only road which was in utilization right from the beginning that is 1995, which was approved by the Central Government under provision of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 therein. There is no other road in utilization. I have inspected the area on 04.07.2014. It was noticed that there is no other road in utilization and the present road is the only road available in the field as on date. The appropriate authority conducted detailed enquiry on the allegation of forming of unauthorized fresh road and found that the allegations have not been substantiated. The Government also accepted the findings and issued orders that the Government of India accorded permission for the road assigned to the trust and recommended that the permitted road may be assigned in the Nallur Reserved Forest Map and necessary entries may be made in the connected record. Thus the subject matter of laying of unauthorized road and black topping road was settled at Government level.

(2) Action taken report relating to allegation of Vigilance and Anti-Corruption

The Government in G.O. (D).No.271, Environment and Forests Department dated 08.10.2010 issued orders that an appropriate enquiry conducted a detailed enquiry into the allocation ^{allegation} (A.O.-1 Thiru. V. Palani, I.F.S., formerly District Forest Officer, Chengalpattu, AO-2 Thiru. V. Kamaraj, formerly Forest Ranger, Tambaram and AO-3 Thiru. C. Sreerangaram (Retd) formerly ^{Forest} District Ranger, Tambaram had committed illegal activities after getting illegal gratification allowed in the Sapthagiri Educational Trust to use the forest land to an extent of 15 Mtrs x 720 Mtrs. Etc., 10800 Sq.Ft in the Nallur Reserved Forest area to form unauthorized road without any public interest and caused a loss to a tune of Rs.2 Crores to the Forest Department by defacing forest boundary, cutting and removing valuable forest cover including sandal and red sanders saplings in the Reserved Forest) against the officers and the subordinates of the Forest Department and given the findings and recommendations that the allegation have not been substantiated. The Government have accepted the finding of the appropriate enquiry authority and dropped further actions on the allegations.

The Government in letter No.16529/FR.Spl.A/2008-4 dated 08.10.2010 informed that the appropriate enquiry authority which has conducted enquiry into the allegation against Thiru. V. Palani I.F.S. formerly District Forest Officer, Chengalpattu Division, V. Kamaraj, then Ranger, Tambaram and C. Sreerangaram, Forest Ranger (Retired), Tambaram Range has given the following recommendations:-

"The detailed enquiry revealed that the permitted cart track is unassigned one. The same was requested by the Trust and the Government of India accorded permission. Therefore, it is recommended that the permitted cart road may be assigned in the Nallur Reserved Forest map and necessary entries may be made in the connected records."

As per the said Government orders necessary action may have to be initiated to make necessary entry of the fact of permitting the cart road

laid in the Nallur forest in the forest map as well as in the connected records. In this record, in pursuance to the PCCF reference No.TS3/28217/2000 dt. 28.01.2008 and other reminders, a clear S.I. Sheet mapping of the road as per the orders issued by the Government of India by utilizing the GPS and duly recording the latitudes and longitudes was under examination. I found that the S.I. Sheet can be prepared duly mapping in the GPS only with the resources available in the G.I.S office of the PCCF. I have submitted a request to prepare the S.I. Sheet with due technicalities and it is under examination. After the preparation of the said S.I. Sheet and map, appropriate action is to be taken to notify the revised map duly following the procedures laid down therefor. I will pursue the matter with the G.I.S officials and expedite S.I. Sheet and Map.

(3) Detailed report on the recent proposal for widening the existing road involving diversion of 0.56 ha duly analyzing the matter in depth and after field inspection.

The matter has been examined in depth. While reminding for orders on the proposal dated 09.12.2013, the Sathagiri Educational Trust in their representation dated 23.06.2014, has given detailed submission and the crux are as follows:-

Lawful road - The total width and length is 12X700 meters and 0.84 hectares of land. We have handed over 1.68 hectares of land as mandated by the State Government and the Government of India as per the provision of Central Forest Conservator^y Act, 1980. We have no idea in any manner to violate the provisions of law. We have not laid any new road. It is the fact that the road on the forest land which was utilized by the public was also utilized by the College with the permission till year of 2000 and it was subsequently maintained after the permission from the Government of India. The contention that the right of way is away from the existing road is not known to College. The Trust believed that the approach road being utilized by the public as well as the institution is

58

the right of way No.6. In fact on ground there is no other road ever in the other place as being contended by the forest officials as right of way No.6. The area other than the road being used, is in the nature of forest with scrub and deciduous on ground.

Protection of Forest - If the Colleges and other Educational Institutions / Trust have to develop the road, in the right of way No.6, as claimed by the officials, then the forest have to be cleared afresh which cause pressure on the existing forest. The claim of the officials is based on record and not on fact on ground. Thus in order to protect the existing forest, the claim of officials may kindly be rectified duly correcting the record.

Increase of Forest land and Forest cover - As stated the Trust caused development of 1.68 hectares of land as forest against the sanction of a 0.84 hectares of land assign to the Trust with the permission of the Government of India. The present request for widening additional 8 meters in to $12 + 8 =$ meters the road to 20 meters works out to 0.56 hectares of land for diversion with the permission of the Government of India. The Trust is ready to handover 1.12 hectares of land to be developed into forest with the cost paid by the Trust. Thus the forest not only fully covered but developed double the area as advised by the CMDA as per the Central FC Act 1980 conditions vide references second and four cited. Thus the forest area and forest cover is developed and increased and the object of Forest Conservation Act, 1980 is being served.

Statutory mandate - The widening of existing road is only to comply with the mandate of second master plan of the Madras City.

No tree cutting - In the proposed additional area, no tree cutting is involved.

Maintenance of 1/3rd tree cover - We undertake to maintain 1/3rd of our Trust patta land covered with tree/green cover as envisaged by State and National policy.

Planting Trees We also undertake to plant reasonable number of trees as desired by the authorities in the land beside the existing road and to develop and conserve the deciduous forest into forest with more than 4% tree cover or any other place, if permission is granted by the Forest Department or through the Forest Department.

The Trust have requested to regularize the existing road which they are utilizing since 1995 year, which was developed and utilized in terms of the orders of the Government of India, Ministry of Environment and Forests Regional office (Southern Zone), letter No. F(C)A/11-2/18/TN/RC dated 15.09.2003 and 13.12.2004 and the State Government orders issued in G.O.Ms.No.83, Environment and Forests Department dated 21.08.2006, if it is necessary and to grant permission to assign 0.56 ha of forest land in Nallur Reserved Forest for widening the existing approach road from 12 meters to 20 meters to comply with the statutory mandate of CMDA, as requested in our proposal dated 09.12.2013 under section 2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.

In the light of the orders of the Government in G.O. (D).No.271, Environment and Forests Department dated 08.10.2010 and the Government orders in letter No.16529/FR.Spl.A/2008-4 dated 08.10.2010 and the pleadings made in the representation of Sapthagiri Educational Trust dated 23.06.2014, a factual report on the road, which is in utilization since 1995 and approved by the Government of India, Ministry of Environment and Forests Regional office (Southern Zone), letter No. F(C)A/11-2/18/TN/RC dated 15.09.2003 and 13.12.2004, as submitted above may be sent to the Government of India.

Taking into account that the Government of India has already permitted the road under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, the orders of the State Government in G.O. (D).No.271, Environment and Forests Department dated 08.10.2010 and the Government orders in letter No.16529/FR.Spl.A/2008-4 dated 08.10.2010 to permit the cart road which was permitted to the trust and action is being pursued to assigned

the same in the Nallur Reserved Forest map and necessary entries may be made in the connected records and question of fresh road and black topping by the trust was settled, the novel object of the proposal for development of wisdom of education and the proposal for widening the road is to comply with the mandate of second master plan of the Madras city, the present proposal dated 09.12.2013 to grant permission to assign 0.56 ha of forest land in Nallur Reserved Forest for widening the existing approach road from 12 meters to 20 meters may be recommended, subject to the conditions that (1) all usual conditions such as compassionate as Net Present Value and other conditions to be laid by the Central Government and State Government and other officers of the Forest Department shall be complied with, (2) the widening of the road shall not cause any damage to the adjacent forest area, (3) the widening / maintenance of road shall be carried out only in the presence of / informing the forest officers, (4) keep the Trust area with green cover as stated by the Trust.

I submit that with reference to the above subjects cited, I am furnishing herewith the details called for in the Government of India letter 4th cited as follows.

i). Map with DGPS co-ordinates of the forest area diverted under FCA, 1980 and the present alignment of the road on filed.

a) As informed, DGPS survey map of the 700m length and 12m wide (0.84 ha) road used by M/s.Sapthagiri Educational Trust leading to their educational institutions through the Nallur RF and area marked in the Map (Survey of India Topo sheet and google earth map) are enclosed as Annexure-I.

b) DGPS reading of the proposed road widening work proposed by the user agency for 700m length and 8m wide (0.56 ha) and 40mx20m (0.08 ha) area near the entrance of M/s Sapthagiri Educational Trust and area marked in the map (Survey of India Topo sheet and google earth map) are enclosed as Annexure-II.

ii) Present position of the Right of Way No.6 for which clearance was sought after reporting a violation happened in 2021.

a) As per the Reserved Forest Notification (copy enclosed. Annexure III) Right of Way No.6 description recorded as follows:

"From Track No.4 to track No.5 about Thirty six and half chains through forest field No.366 of Naduveerapattu. It enters the block to the south of the south-west corner of forest field 429 of Punthandalam and joins track No.5 close to the point where the latter crosses the southern boundary of Punthandalam village."

b) The Right of Way No.6 is not in use and presently it is covered with natural vegetation. A copy of Map (Survey of India Topo Sheet and google earth map) marking the Right of Way No.6 is enclosed as Annexure -IV.

c). Road formed and utilized under the approval obtained under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 by the user agency is not connected with the Right of Way No.6.

iii). Reason for sudden change in the alignment away from the alignment proposed in the proposal the extent of violation and the action taken on the reported violations.


On verification of google earth map of 2002, it is ascertained that before the approval of diversion proposal of 0.84 Ha by the Government of India (Stage I) approval accorded during 2003 and Stage II approval accorded during 2004 the User agency is using the pathway leading to college campus and the same path has been subsequently black topped after the Forest Clearance approval accorded during 2004. Black topping of path leads to Educational Institutions were carried out during the period of 2004-2007. Now widening of this existing road has been requested by the educational trust.

I submit that from the above, there is no sudden change in the alignment away from the alignment proposed in the proposal noticed and violation noticed.



Forests, Chennai issued orders for the use of cart track referred as right of
way No.6 in Nallur Reserved Forest notification for use by college authorities
from 17.10.1994 to 16.10.1995 on payment of permit fee. This permit was

subsequently renewed by the Chief Conservator of Forest Chennai upto to the year 2000.

2. Subsequently on the orders of the Chief Conservator of Forests (Territorial) Chennai, the District Forest Officer, Chengalpattu Division was permitted to accord necessary permission to the college authorities with usual terms and condition on payment of permit fee for the use of right of way cart track No.6 in Nallur Reserved Forest. Permit was issued every year on payment of lease to Sapthagiri Educational Trust for period of 1994-2000.

3. Based on the representation made by the Sapthagiri Educational Trust, Government E&F Department in letter No.11217/FRXII/2000-3 Dt.26.02.2000 requested the educational trust to submit necessary proposals under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 to the District Forest Officer, Chengalpattu Division.

4. Based on proposal furnished under Section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for diversion of 0.84 ha of forest land for laying access road to reach Engineering College to a length of 700 meters and to a width of 12 meters by M/s.Sapthagiri Educational Trust in Principal Chief Conservator of Forests Ref.No.TS3/28217/20000, dated.10.07.2001, Government of India has issued Stage I approval in Letter No.F(C)A/11.2/118/TN/RC/1200, dated 15.09.2003 for diversion of 0.84 ha of forest land in Nallur RF and in response to the compliance report sent to Government by the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Chennai the Government of India in letter No.F(C)A/11.2/118TN/RC Dt.13.12.2004 has accorded Stage II final approval. State Government Order in this regard has been issued in G.O.Ms.No.83, Environment and Forest (FR.10) Department Dt.21.08.2006.

5. Meanwhile, during the year 2000 itself, it has been noticed during the field inspection of then Conservator of Forests, Chennai Circle, that a road has been formed in Nallur Reserved Forest without any authority, on enquiry it was ascertained that the existing cart track that was a right of way had been widened by Education trust. This violation was

73

reported to higher authorities. A case was registered against M/s.Sapthagiri Educational Trust under TNFA, 1882 and compounded.

6. The Conservator of Forests, Chennai Circle during June 2006, has reported that, the trust not only black topped the road, but formed a new road about 400 meters away from the original right of way path No.6. New road has been formed encroaching the forest area by fresh cutting across Nallur Reserved Forest instead of improving the original right of way No.6 for which approval has been accorded by the Government of India.

7. Available records indicate a discrepancy between the notified right of way No. 6 in RF notification and the actual path used on lease by M/s.Sapthagiri Educational Trust since 1994. A copy of map of year 1994 is attached to this report illustrates this difference. The right of way number 6 mentioned in 1994 map is not in align with the RF notification.

8. As per CF inspection report of 2000, it was mentioned that user agency had widened the same pathway used by them earlier through lease. However, in 2006 it was reported that road was laid down in a place 400 meters away from the original right of way path No.6, which is in actual 850 meters away from right of way number 6. In 2007, DFO mentioned that the road was laid down on right of way no. 7, though it is not in align with mentioned right of way.

9. During the earlier forest area diversion of 0.84 ha of forest land for pay leading M/s.Sapthagiri Educational Institutions, over a distance of 700 meter length and 12 meter width (8400 Sq.m or 0.84 ha) has been allowed. In this, there is no mention / deduction of area done for the path allowed for right of way number 6.

10. In case, widening of existing pathway is allowed, area of right of way exist for the path must be deducted and the widening width area alone should be proposed for forest area diversion. In the above case, forest area diversion of entire 12 meter width for a length of 700 meter for 0.84 ha of forest land has been requested by the user agency and has been recommended by DFO/CF/PCCF/State Government and Government of

India also accorded approval for diversion of 0.84 ha area (700m x 12m = 8400 Sq.m or 0.84 ha). There is no deduction was made for the existing cart track pathway of 12 feet (3.60m) allowed as right of way.

11. In addition, As per RF notification right of number 6 starts from right of way number 4 and end with right of way number 5, Length of right way number 6 is 730 meter. Right of way no 6 does not leads to the M/s.Sapthagiri Educational Institute. Also, user agency had applied for 700 meter of road inside forest area and length of right of way number 6 is 730 meter inside forest area.

12. The requested diversion area of 0.84 hectares matches the actual area utilized by the existing road. For the diversion of 0.84 ha of forest land the user agency has handed over double the extent of 1.68 ha of non-forest CA land of their patta land in the Forest Department.

13. From the above facts, it was ascertained that the forest are diversion order obtained from Government of India during 2004 is not applicable for the right of way no. 6.

As per Nallur Reserved Forest notification Right of Way no.6 starts from right of way number no.4 and end with right of way no.5 inside forest itself, right of way no.6 does not leads to the M/s.Sapthagiri Educational Institute.

User agency had applied and permission was issued by government of India to divert 700 meter length and 12 meter width (0.84 ha) of forest land which matches with the existing approach road of same length and width.

Thus, From the above facts, it was ascertained that the forest area diversion order obtained from Government of India during 2004 is not applicable for the right of way no.6. Hence, it should not be considered as violation ascribing to fact that the existing road is not in right of way no.6.



After field inspection of the leased land by all Forest Authorities and after due satisfaction of our performance of the road-usage, WE were advised to submit proposal for 'diversion' of Forest land under FC act 1980, in accordance with all the related **Rules and Regulations, Norms and Standards of State and Central Government** under FC Act 1980. Accordingly, Our **Sapthagiri Educational Trust** submitted proposal under **Section 2** for the diversion of **0.84 Hectare** Forest land in **NALLUR RF** to enable formation of regular approach road to Our **Sri Sairam Engineering College** and **6 Educational Institutions Campus Complex**.

On the Remmendations forwarded by Forest Authorities of Government of Tamilnadu on our FC Act proposal, Government of India granted **Stage I Approval** dated **15/09/2003** and **Stage II Approval** dated **13/12/2004** and finally, State Government Issued **Administrative Orders** dated **21/08/2006** to form regular Road by **700 metres** length and **12 metres** width in the same alignment as existed on field as early as in 1995 in which lease road was granted by **District Forest Officer, Kancheepuram**. 


