1	In Response to observation No. 2 and undertaking stated to be placed in folder whereas same s required to b uploaded in PARIVESH Portal.	An undertaking in this regard is already submitted at page no. 66 of the proposal folder. And same has been uploaded on the online portal at <b>sr. no. 34</b> titled as <b>“TEC and IA undertaking”</b>
2	In observation No. 4(i) GoI has suggest to consolidate the all dumping sites in single point, but no comments in this regard has been submitted.	These sites cannot be reduced, as they represent the minimum area required for dumping after utilization in accordance with the project proposal and structural design. Justification in this regard has been provided in the additional information under <b>Sr. No. 26</b> , titled <b>“Justification Regarding Dumping Site.”</b>

3	In observation No. 7, GoI has also asked to provide the List of Projects having installed capacity in the Nallah where SHEP proposed i.e. which are under construction, Projects having total capacity which are at various stages of the investigation, and Projects having installed capacity which are yet to be allotted form DoE (Directorate of Energy, HP), but nothing has been mentioned in this regard.	It is submitted that the power generation capacity of the Nallah, as issued by HIMURJA (Nodal Agency of the Government of Himachal Pradesh), has been uploaded in the additional information details at <b>Sr. No. 27</b> , titled "Power Generation Capacity." Furthermore, the letter received from the DoE, which mentions all projects in the Beas Basin, has been uploaded on the portal at <b>Sr. No. 35</b> , titled "DoE Letter to Choj-1."
4	GoI has asked for KML file showing boundaries of nearest Protected Areas (PAs) and their Eco-Sensitive Zones (ESZ) along with the distance of each HEP in the area/Landscape from these PAs and their ESZ, which is stated to be submitted but no such e-mail received in this office.
