



(i)	Short narrative of the proposal and project / Schemes for which the forest land is required.	Road Construction Department, Govt. of Bihar has decided to Construction of 3x14.00 M RCC High Level Bridge over Dhathuria River in 23rd Km of SHRAWAN-BAKSHILA ROAD in the district of Jamui for the year 2016-17. This part is to be taken up under the control of Road Construction Department Patna. The project Construction of H L Bridge Connected to Deoghar Distt. (Jharkhand). Index Map of project road is attached as Annexure 1. Total length of 0.160 Km of project road passing under the administrative boundary of Jamui Forest Division, Bihar. Involves felling of trees from the existing plantation which is notified as project forest.

Project of H.L Bridge project length 0.160 km section of RCD, Govt. of Bihar under RCD, Road Division, Jamui decided Construction of H.L Bridge at Dulanpur on Dhathuria River in 23rd Km under Plan head. The project Construction of H L Bridge section of transverse through forest area but avenue plantation of existing road has been declared as notified forest by the Govt. of Bihar under the Forest (Conservation) Act. 1980. Therefore, Forest Clearance to be accorded from ministry of Environment and Forests, Govt. of India for felling of trees notified forest land.
