

Sub: Justification report- Submission-Reg

En Uru project is designed to create a permanent platform for the tribes in the State to support to make a livelihood with their indigenous skills in craft, art, architecture, medicinal practice, agriculture & cuisine.

Project is decided to be implemented in 25 acres of land at the Priyadharshini Tea Estate, Lakkidi Division owned by Scheduled Tribe Development Department of Government of Kerala which was a part of vested forest land allotted to revenue department for tribal resettlement.

Project site is located in the top hill area surrounded by deep and semi deep valley. the distance of the valley base from the project site is 2.5 kms which made the project to seek drinking water source either from the top hill with the support of gravity force or pumping from open well at valley base. We have done water feasibility surveys with the concerned departments of the Government like Ground Water Department, Minor Irrigation Department and Kerala Water Authority. Based on the consensus of the advice of the concerned departments, we identified three drinking water sources for the project to collect water thorough out the year as below.


1. Water stream located at the top hill area with the support of gravity force. (Submitted for clearance via proposal No: FP/KL/WATER/31414/2018)
2. Water stream located near by the project site road (Nearby second hairpin bend) (submitted for clearance via proposal No: FP/KL/WATER/31534/2018)
3. Open well point/open well owed by MRS Pookode located nearby Entrance gate of veterinary college, Pookode (submitted for clearance via proposal No: FP/KL/WATER/31534/2018)

I inform you that we could not find any alternative water sources such as open well points or bore well for the project due to the location and nature of the project site. We require 0.454 hectare land from the forest for implementing the said water schemes for the project.

Hence I request you to take further steps for sanctioning our proposals.
