I have been directed to forward herewith a comprehensive revised vision statement for H.P. High Court, H.P. Judicial Academy and Courts Subordinate to the High Court of H.P., which has been approved by Hon'ble the Chief Justice on the recommendations of Hon'ble State Court Management Systems (SCMS) Committee, and also a copy of letter dated 8th October, 2013 received from Shri Ravindra Maithani, the then Secretary General, Hon'ble Supreme Court of India alongwith copy of National Court Management Systems (NCMS) - Policy and Action Plan released by Hon'ble the Chief Justice, on 27.9.2012 and request you to implement the Revision Vision Statement and the aforesaid National Court Management Systems (NCMS) - Policy and Action Plan in letter and spirit.

Hon'ble the Chief Justice was further pleased to order that in case some of the actions which are required to be taken during the financial year, 2014-15, are not taken up to 31st March, 2015, then the same should be taken alongwith the actions required to be taken, during the financial year, 2015-16.

His lordship Hon'ble the Chief Justice, on the recommendations of Hon'ble SCMS Committee, has also been pleased to order that the undersigned and other Registrars of H.P. High Court, Member Secretary, H.P. State Legal Services Authority, the Director, H.P. Judicial Academy and Central Project Co-ordinator, H.P. High Court, shall take up the matters with the government of Himachal Pradesh as well as the government of India for providing funds for the various projects required to be undertaken as per the various statement under the centrally sponsored schemes wherever possible or raise an additional demand for funds from the government of Himachal Pradesh, during the financial year, 2015-16 wherever required.

His lordship has also been pleased to order that the undersigned and Registrar (Inspection) shall take up with the government, the issues with regard to commissioning of construction work of new High Court building in place of old High Court buildings, taking steps for setting up solar energy plant for back-up energy in High Court, for taking steps for earmarking/acquisition/ identification of land for construction of six residential earmarked bungalows for Judges of High Court and creation of the posts of Judicial Officers during the financial year, 2014-15 itself as envisioned in the vision statement.

I have also further been directed to say that Hon'ble the Chief Justice has been pleased to order that with a view to effectively monitor the implementation of the above referred NCMS Policy and Action Plan and the Revised Vision Statement, a quarterly meeting of the SCMS Committee shall be held preceded by a meeting of the CDPC (Court Development and Planning Committee) and in such meeting, Action Taken Reports on the Vision Statement and SCMS - Policy and Action Plan shall be called from all the quarters concerned and firstly the same shall be scrutinised by CDPC and thereafter presented before the SCMS Committee for perusal and further directions.
