

JOINT INSEPECTION REPORT

Joint inspection of site for diversion of 01-41-94 ha. of Govt./forest land for construction of extension of Judicial Courts Complex & complete separate Court Block for Juvenile Justice Board at Shingla Chak under the jurisdiction of Rampur Tehsil, Distt. Shimla was done on **05-05-2017**.

Two possible alignments/sites were proposed by the user agency for construction of extension of Judicial Courts Complex & complete separate Court Block for Juvenile Justice Board, Both these sites comprises Govt./Forest land. Site No. 1 involve 01-41-94 hectare of Govt./Forest and 15 saplings, 6 trees of different species are involved for removal. In the site No. 2, 01-52-00 hectare of Govt./Forest land involved for diversion and 150 saplings, 95 trees of different species are involved for removal. Keeping in view of the minimum area and less felling of trees, Joint Inspection Committee is of the view that diversion of land coming in the site No. 1 involve less forest land and entails less felling of trees and there are Govt./forest land interspersed in both the alignments, there is no scope for avoidance of Govt./forest land and diversion of 01-41-94 ha. of Govt./forest is bare minimum and cannot be escaped.

The Joint Inspection Committee, therefore, recommends that the Govt./forest land measuring 01-41-94 ha. coming in the alignment No.-1 as detailed in Check list-6 enclosed as Annexure-I in the proposal be diverted under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for construction of extension of Judicial Courts Complex & complete separate Court Block for Juvenile Justice Board.
