This project falls in the south district of Sikkim. This road will connect the Wok village (which is approximately 28 km from Namchi towards the south direction) and Chemchey village (which is 15 km away from Namchi towards the north direction) the proposed road is 10 km in length. After implementation of this project the people of Chemchey, Lachithang, Padam dara, upper Wok village and adjoining village too. Presently there are no any means of transportation facilities to this village so as to connect with the District Namchi & other important Towns. The majority of the population is farmers and depends on the agricultural products. This road on completion will act as the lifeline of the people of the area for transportation of their agricultural products to the town & help to transport their daily basic household amenities. It will also help them to reach the district offices, centre/facilities provided by the Government.
