Proposal for Diversion of Forest land For Construction, Construction of 2-lane specification road with Paved shoulder as re-alignment (Greenfield alignment) of existing stretch between Legship to Gyalshing of NH-510 (Design chainage from km 75.000 to km 90.210) under SARDP-NE Phase 'A' on EPC mode in the state of Sikkim (Package-VI)

## **DETAIL NOTE ON THE PROJECT**

Ministry of Road Transport & Highways, Govt. of India intends to undertake massive upgradation of different National Highways in North East area under SARDP Scheme. In the contex a section of National Highway (NH-510) from Singtam-Tarku-Ravngla-Legship-Gyalshing has to be upgraded to 2-lane/2 lane with paved shoulder to augment capacity of the highway, with enhanced safety features.

The Project Corridor takes off from Km 62.800 on existing NH-10 at Singtam in East Sikkim and terminates at Gyalshing, which are runs towards South – East to North-West direction passing through a number of towns like Singtam- Tarku- Ravngla- Legship- Gyalshing within South & West District.

- (i) NH-510 from "Singtam to Tarku" (Package 1: 16.00 Km.)
- (ii) NH-510 from "Tarku Ravangla" (Package -2: 16.50 Km.)
- (iii) NH-510 from "Tarku Ravangla (Tunnel)" (Package –3: 1.1Km.)
- (iv) NH-510 from "Ravangla Legship" (Package 4: 26.34 Km.)
- (v) NH-510 from "Legship Gyalshing" (Package 5: 16.16Km)
- (vi) NH-510 from "Legship Gyalshing" (Package 6: 15.21Km

The Forest land proposed for Diversion is from Legship to Gyalshing i.e. From Chainage 75+000 Km to 90+210 km (package –VI) The total forest land Proposed for diversion is about 2.6808 Ha of forest land is under revenue block proposed for road construction work.
