
We are pleased to inform that Greenko Group is one of India's leading Renewable Energy companies, replacing fossil fuels with integrated decarbonized energy and grid assets enabling sustainable and affordable energy, with a net installed capacity of 6.2 GWdc across 15 States in India.

Greenko Group through its subsidiary- Greenko Energies Private Limited (GEPL), has envisaged to develop off-stream Pumped Storage Project (PSP) near Gandhi Sagar Reservoir in Madhya Pradesh. The proposed upper reservoir is located near Village Khemla Block, and Power House is located near Rodna Village, Tehsil Rampura in District Neemach, while the existing dam - Gandhi Sagar Reservoir will be used as lower reservoir.

This is to inform you that Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Government of India has accorded Term of Reference (ToR) vide letter No. vide letter no. J-12011/22/2019- IA-I dated 28.02.2020. Further, application seeking amendment in ToR was submitted To MoEF&CC due to revision in installed capacity (1440 MW) and minor changes in project layout; and the said proposal was appraised by EAC meeting dated 02.12.2020.

Total 301.96 Ha Reserve Forest (RF) land is required for the construction of proposed 1440 MW-MP30 Gandhi Sagar Off-Stream Pumped Storage Project, District Neemuch, Madhya Pradesh by M/s Greenko Energies Pvt. Ltd. and the project is falls in villages namely Khella Gram Panchyat and Bhagatpura & Rodna under Amarpura Gram Panchyat, under Rampura Forest Range in Neemuch District of Madhya Pradesh. The project Layout plan and the breakup of total land required is enclosed as **Annexure-I**.

We would like to inform that MoEF &CC vide letter no F.N.11-9/1998-FC (pt) dated 03.08.2009 (copy enclosed for your ready reference as **Annexure-II**) has directed the state government for implementation of the Schedule Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights Act, 2006 against the diversion of Forest Land.



In view of above, it is requested to kindly initiate the process for settlement of claims and rights under Schedule Tribe and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers under Forest Rights Act, 2006 and it is also requested to kindly issue the requisite **certificate in form-II (for nonlinear projects)** towards the settlement of all claims and rights over the proposed forest land falling the villages as specified above along with all compliance report as per above mentioned MoEF letter F.N.11-98-FC (pt.) 05.07.2013 dated 05.07.2013 (copy enclosed for your ready reference as **Annexure-III**).
