Secretary, RT&H welcomed the participants. CE(P-4) apprised about 9 new National Highways covering a length of 1535.25 km declared by the Minister during 2011-12 with following details.

Principal Secretary, Govt. of Rajasthan mentioned about poor maintenance of above NHs. He further stated that only few kms of these NHs were repaired by NHAI to some extent but about 545 km length patch - repair has not been done after monsoon, resulting in further deterioration causing immense inconvenience to road user. He therefore requested that these NHs be entrusted back to State PWD and adequate fund be earmarked separately for upkeep of these NHs.

4. CGM NHAI apprised that development works on NH-458, NH-145-D and NH-758 have either been awarded or are under process of award in case of NH-123 the tender is under evaluation. CGM requested that maintenance activities may be carried out by State PWD where agreement is yet to be signed by contractor/concessioner as per extant Ministry's policy. He further informed that DPR preparation for remaining 5 NHs viz NH-158, NH-162(Ext), NH-58(Ext), NH-927-A and NH-709(Ext) is under progression the process of award. CGM NHAI mentioned that NHAI vide letter dated 27th May 2014 conveyed their no objection to entrust above 5 NHs to State PWD for development and maintenance.
