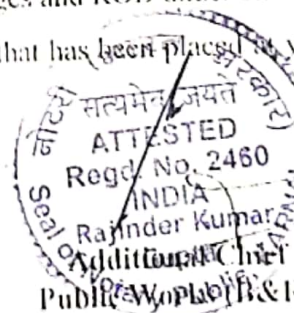

Construction of 2 lane ROB on Jind Panipat Railway Line at LC No. 38-A at  
Railway km.51/6-7 crossing Panipat Safidon Jind Bhiwani road (SH-14) Road  
ID-7626, District Panipat.

Reference your H.O.No. 1858/HSRDC, dated 09.07.2019 on the subject noted  
above.

2. Governor of Haryana is pleased to accord administrative approval for  
amounting to **Rs. 3359.89 Lakh (Rupees Thirty Three Crore Fifty Nine Lakhs and Eighty  
Nine Thousands only)** for the construction of ROB on LC No. 38-A at Railway km.51/6-7  
crossing Panipat Safidon Jind Bhiwani road (SH-14) Road ID-7626, District Panipat on 50:50 sharing  
with Railways. Railway Department shall share 50% expenditure of the construction cost of Railway  
portion and approaches excluding utility shifting and land acquisition etc. Railway has not so far  
intimated their share for construction of this ROB. Usually expenditure on Railway portion is less than  
share contribution of 50% cost. Accordingly Haryana PWD B&R take reimbursement of its expenditure  
beyond its share and reimbursement taken is deposited under revenue Head of account (HOA).

3. The expenditure involved is chargeable to the under Head "P-01-08-5054-03-  
SH-101-81-99-16-Construction of Bridges and ROB under state scheme" and total expenditure  
under it should not exceed the amount that has been placed at your disposal during the current  
financial year.
