TO WHOMSOEVER IT MAY CONCERN

For widening (four lane) and strengthening of Etah- Kasganj Road (O.D.R., total length = 24.300 km.) and Bareilly- Mathura Road (S.H.-33, total length = 16.500 km.) to connect the Etah and Kasganj districts with four lane road, 24.088 hect. Of forest land falling in District Kasganj is proposed to be diverted in favour of Executive Engineer (P.D.) P.W.D. Kasganj. This forest land falls in the jurisdiction of gram sabhas of willages-Nadrai, Bankner, Mamo, Goraha, Prahaladpur and Kasganj Cily in Tehsil- Kasganj, District- Kasganj.

In compliance of the directions contained in circular no. F. No. 11-09/98-FC (pt.) dated 28th October, 2014 of Government of India, Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change (Forest Conservation Division), it is certified that the aforesaid forest land proposed to be diverted is plantation which was notified as "forest" less than 75 years prior to te 13th day of December, 2005 and is located in villages having no recorded population of Scheduled Tribes as per census – 2001 and the census – 2011.
